WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP

In November, we continued to carry out our life-changing projects in Iraq, Pakistan, Palestine, Somalia, Syria, and Yemen, delivering projects that support education, healthcare, shelter, and clean water. In the UK, we continued our regular volunteering projects, and launched our annual Wrap Up campaign.

Read on to learn more about our field work in each country over the past months.

IRAQ

WINTER



This month, we provided **100 families** in Halabja, Iraq, with winter kits containing a thick winter blanket, a kerosene stove and hand sanitiser, supporting a total of **500 people**.



We distributed winter kits in Iraq to help keep vulnerable families warm this winter.

PAKISTAN

EDUCATION



In November, we constructed two new classrooms at a school in the remote drought-hit region of Tharparkar, Pakistan. These classrooms will provide **100 children** with a safe space to learn and thrive.

HEALTH



This month, we opened an e-clinic in Rahim Yar Khan, providing patients in remote villages with online consultations with specialist doctors in Lahore for free.

MEDICINE

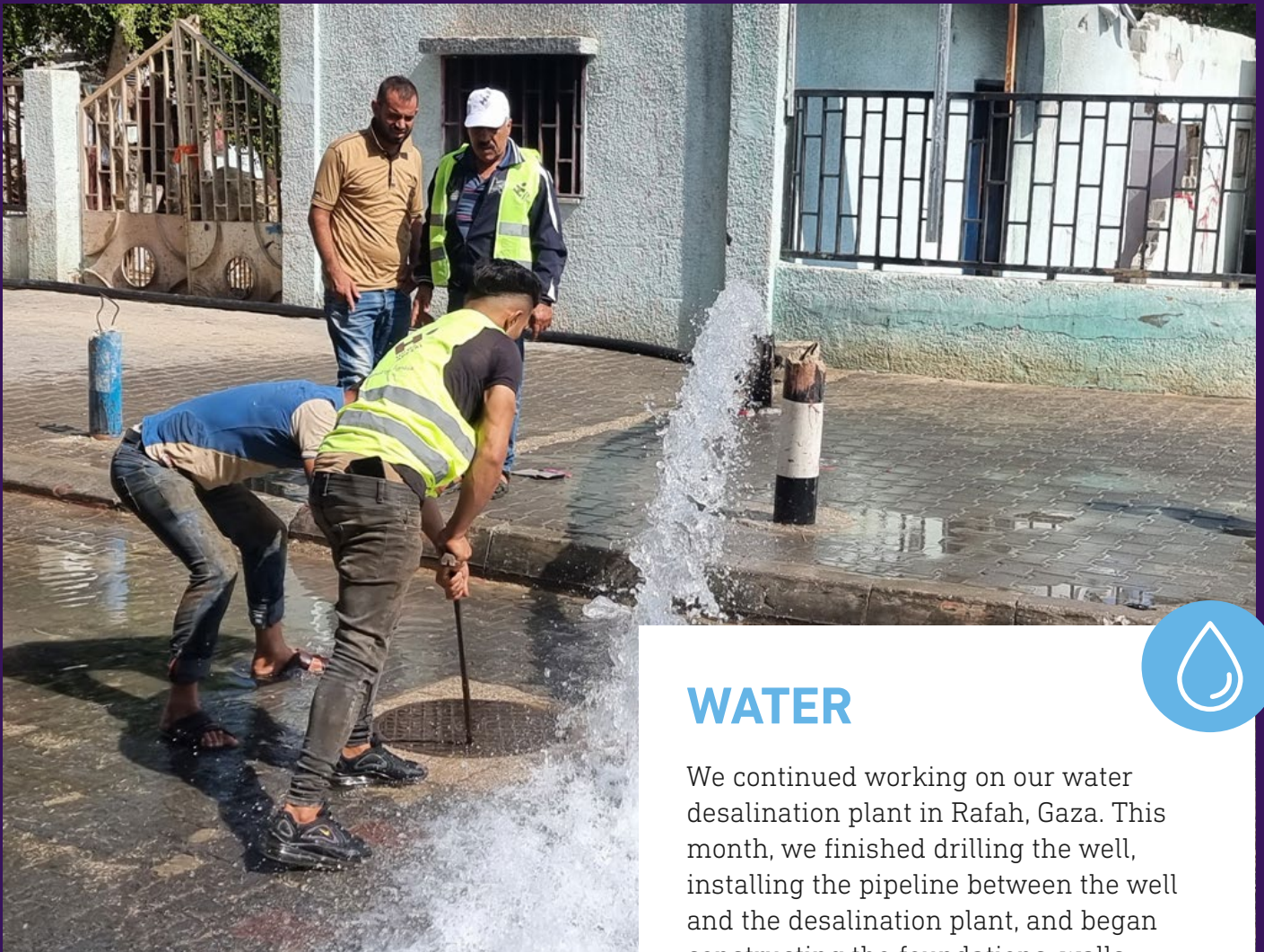


In November, we met with the health ministry of Gaza to provide medical supplies to be distributed to hospitals throughout Gaza. These supplies included vascular grafts, syringes, and other critical items.

We continued our emergency response to the May attacks in Gaza, providing medical supplies including disposable staplers, bone wax, surgical gowns and urine bags to Gaza's hospitals.

WATER



We continued working on our water desalination plant in Rafah, Gaza. This month, we finished drilling the well, installing the pipeline between the well and the desalination plant, and began constructing the foundations, walls and electricity of the well building.

EDUCATION

We've completed our renovations of Zaid Ben Haritha school in northern Gaza. Over the last couple of months we've repaired the school's plumbing, electrics, tiling, windows, doors and roof. Now **600 school children** are in school, enjoying these new facilities.

LIVELIHOODS

Our team in Gaza joined Palestinian citrus farmers to harvest their fruit this month.

SOMALIA



Orphan children in Somalia received essential educational items to help them learn in school.

EDUCATION



This month, we delivered **478 school kits** to orphaned children in Somalia, containing a bag, uniform, books, and pens, helping them to study and maximise their education.

HEALTH



In November, we distributed PPE kits to **two hospitals** in Mogadishu, in partnership with Americares.



"My favorite hobby is studying and reading. I'm an introvert and would rather stay indoors than go out and about. I feel my personality suits me as it lets me focus more on my studies.

"I want to become a doctor when I grow up. I know a lot of children say this but I'm not going to change my mind, our country need doctors. I always attend school to make my dream become a reality."

SYRIA

EDUCATION

In November, we provided **464 displaced children** in Jannat al-Qura camp with school bags, containing exercise books, pens, and stationery, helping them to study in this school year.

SHELTER

Our new homes project in Syria is almost complete and will soon welcome its first families. We've completed construction of **88 homes** with a living space, two rooms, kitchen, bathroom, electricity and running water.



Human Appeal Syria distributed vitamins and medical tablets to different health facilities.

HEALTH

This month, our partners, Vitamin Angels, provided **6,200 vitamins and tablets** to children and pregnant women at our health facilities.

We've also seen an increase in patients at our Mariam primary healthcare centre for displaced people in Idlib. Your support of our Emergency Appeal keeps this centre open.



WINTER

Ahead of our winter distribution in December, we visited displacement camps in northwest Syria to assess where our work will make the greatest difference.

YEMEN



EMERGENCY

This month, we provided **1,000 families** – that's around **7,000 people** – with nutritious food parcels to last the entire month. We also provided each family with clean drinking water.

UK



MENTAL HEALTH

Since Ramadan, we've been providing men of ethnic minority backgrounds with mental health support through therapy and a dial-in service. This November, we reached a milestone of **50 men** helped through therapy and **300 men** supported through the dial-in service.



VOLUNTEERING

Our volunteers and supporters in London, Manchester, Bristol, Bradford, Leicester, and Birmingham have been busy collecting and donating their spare winter coats for our Wrap Up campaign. When we've finished counting, cleaning and sorting each coat, we'll let you know how many we received this year.
