# WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP DECEMBER EDITION

In December, Human Appeal continued working tirelessly to support vulnerable communities across the globe. In Afghanistan, we provided families with chickens and milking goats, offering them a sustainable source of income. In Gaza, we distributed hot meals, water, and medical supplies, including a shipment of medication to a hospital, as well as winter essentials like food parcels, clothes, and set up over 160 tents. In Iraq, we trained entrepreneurs in income-generating businesses, and in Lebanon, we distributed food parcels, hot meals, and renovated a shelter while providing bedding. In Pakistan, our mobile medical camps delivered diagnoses and medicine to patients, while we also supported livelihoods with chicken farms, sewing training, and distributed wheelchairs.

In Senegal, we responded to floods by providing food parcels, hygiene kits, mattresses, 300 wheelchairs, and ran a Back to School campaign for students. In Somalia, we delivered clean water via trucks and trained teachers to support visually impaired students, while in Sudan, we distributed over 1,000 hygiene kits, food parcels, and wheelchairs. Throughout the escalations in Syria, we distributed winter kits, bread, and completed the construction of a mosque and water well, alongside a Back to School event at Al-Sabr School in Al-Zohoor. In Yemen, we provided prosthetic limbs to people with disabilities and ran a cancer awareness campaign for women and girls, continuing our commitment to improve lives in every region.

# AFGHANISTAN



## LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal is providing livelihood training and distributing **20** chickens and two milking goats each to **700** female-headed families. Additionally, **596** families will receive chicken farms and **200** families will receive milking goats across seven villages.

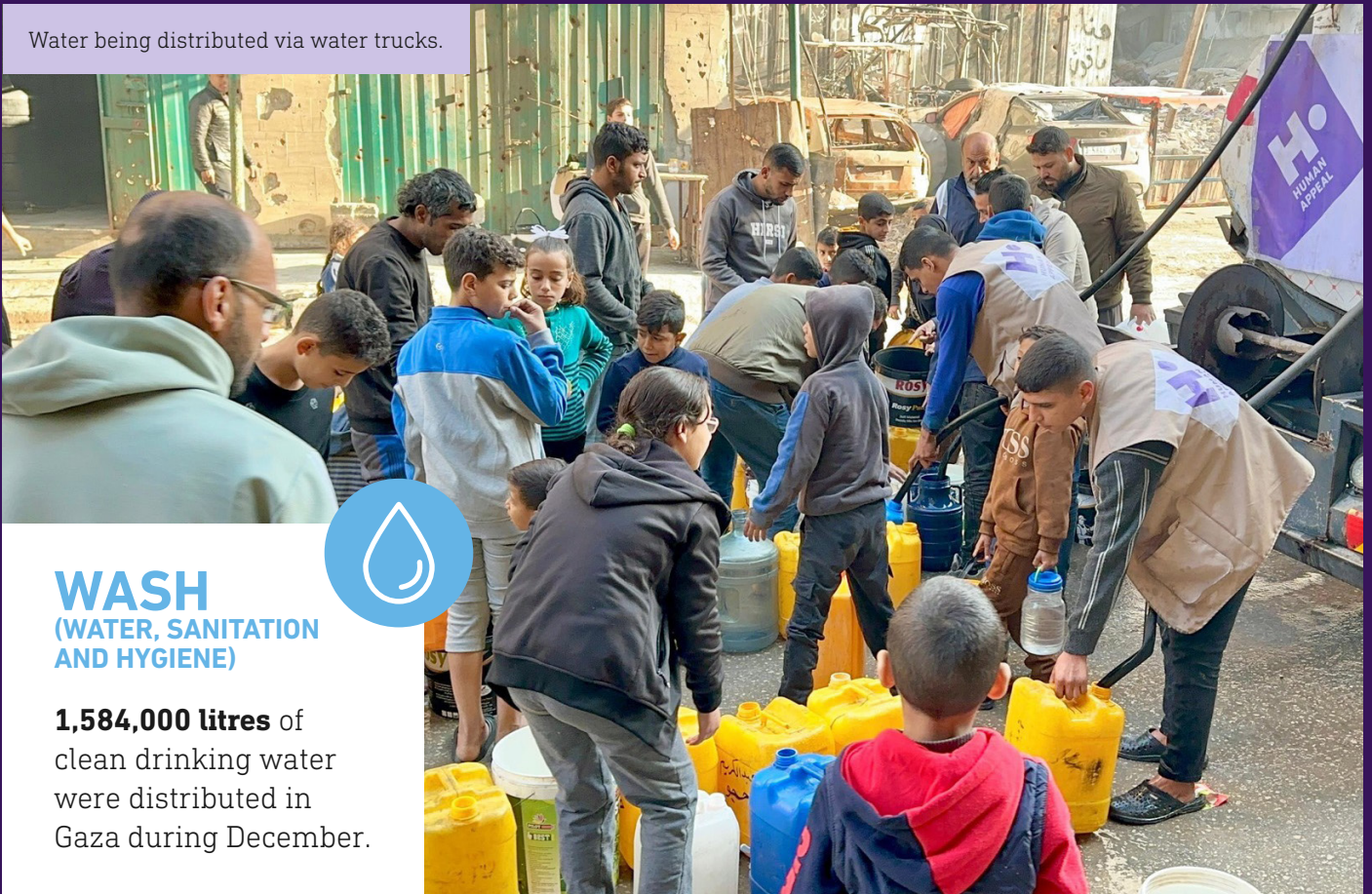


## FOOD SECURITY



In December alone, Human Appeal distributed **731,814** hot meals. So far, we have delivered over **4 million** hot meals to families in Gaza.

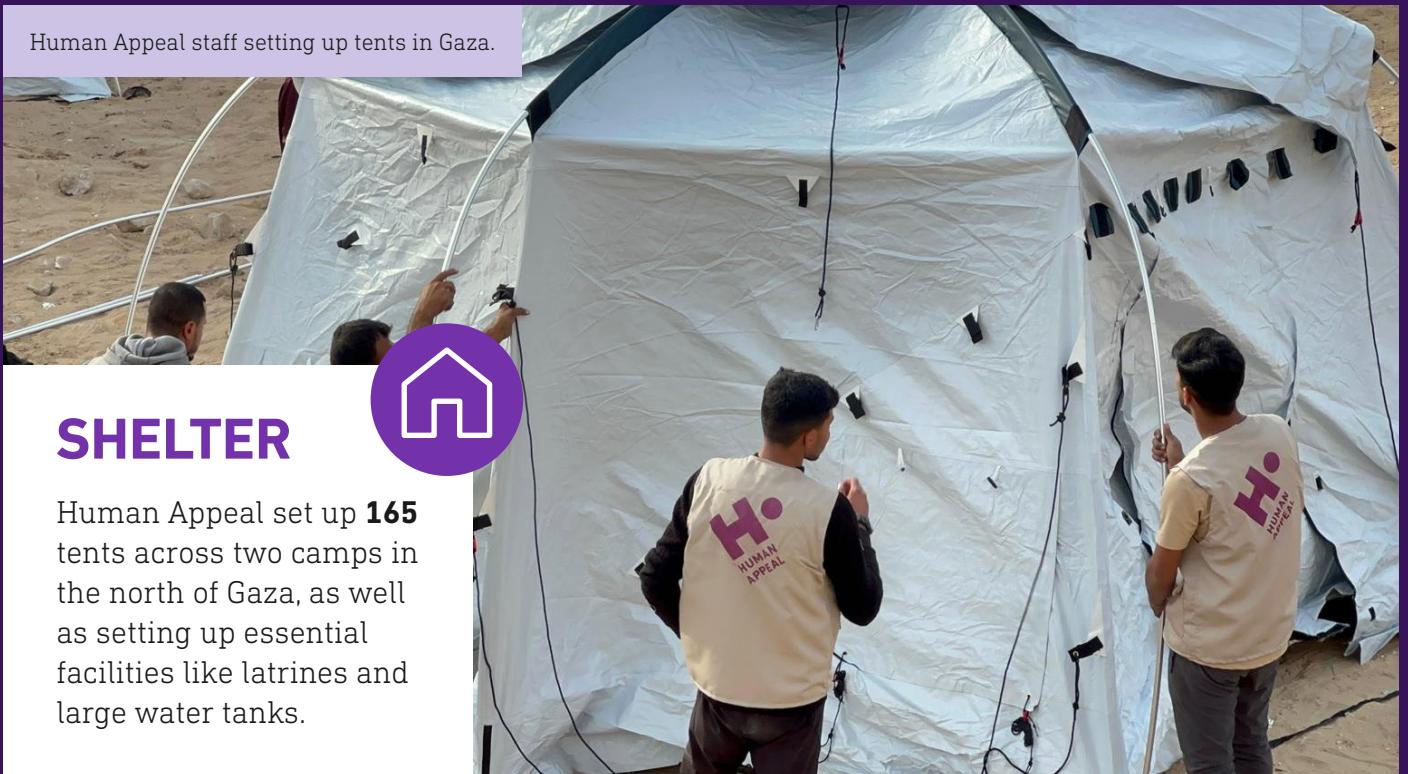


## HEALTH



On December 3rd, Human Appeal delivered a critical shipment of medications to Al Awda Hospital. These medications will treat respiratory, dermatological, reproductive, and orthopaedic illnesses, as well as allergies and chronic diseases, benefiting thousands of patients in need.

## SHELTER



Human Appeal set up **165** tents across two camps in the north of Gaza, as well as setting up essential facilities like latrines and large water tanks.

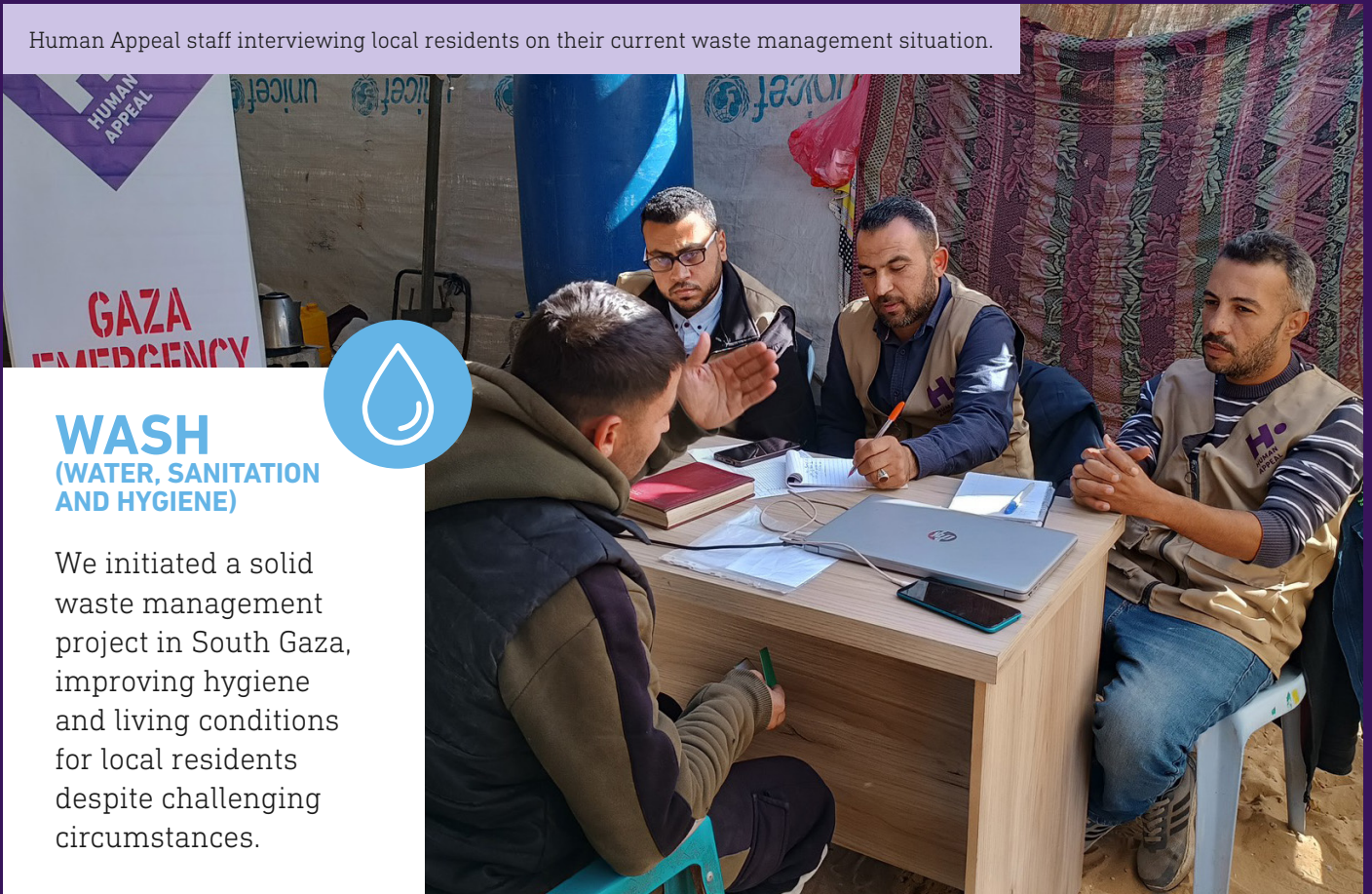


## FOOD SECURITY



We distributed over **169** food parcels to displaced families in Northern Gaza.

## WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We initiated a solid waste management project in South Gaza, improving hygiene and living conditions for local residents despite challenging circumstances.

## LIVELIHOODS

# LEBANON

In Lebanon, Human Appeal distributed emergency supply boxes to families in need.



## EMERGENCY RESPONSE



Human Appeal distributed **983** food parcels, **1,966** packs of bread and **1,966** **2-gallon** bottles of drinking water to **996** families, approximately **4,915** people.

## WINTER

Human Appeal distributed **500** mattresses, **500** blankets and **500** pillows to **100** families displaced from their homes in Lebanon.

## SHELTER

On the 27th November, Human Appeal renovated Al Iman Shelter in Said, Lebanon providing improved living condition to **94** families displaced from their homes.

## FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal distributed **1,200** hot family meals, accompanied by water bottles and hot drinks, to families in North Lebanon, helping to feed **6,000** people.



# PAKISTAN

## LIVELIHOODS

We supported a skills centre in the district of Bagh by providing **15** sewing machines, **5** embroidery machines, stools, **2** tracing tables, irons, and an electric cutter to help women learn marketable skills.

## LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal distributed **31** sewing machines and established a poultry farm in Faisalabad. In the Bagh district, two farmers received kitchen gardening tools and seeds. We also distributed wheelchairs to six individuals in need.

## HEALTH



Our mobile medical camps provided free diagnoses and medicine to **387** patients in a five-day project that occurred in Islamabad, Murree and Taxila in Pakistan.



## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal trained **46** people on honeybee farming methods, and provided them with four starter hives each and necessary equipment for beekeeping.

# SENEGAL

## EMERGENCY RESPONSE



Human Appeal responded to floods in Senegal, providing **500** food parcels, **500** hygiene kits, **500** mattresses, **500** blankets and **1,500** mosquito nets, providing support to **500** families, around **3,000** people.

## EDUCATION



Human Appeal organised a Back to School campaign, distributing school kits containing uniforms, shoes, school bags, notebooks and stationery to children.

## HEALTH



In Sedhiou, Senegal, we distributed **310** wheelchairs, **40** of which are powered by electric motors. Each wheelchair includes an attached hygiene bucket, ensuring recipients have freedom of movement and dignity. The event was overseen by Dr. Ibrahim Sy, Minister of Health and Social Action.



# SOMALIA



## EDUCATION

We trained **122** teachers from three schools on how to support students with visual impairments and identify those in need of assistance.

## WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal completed a month-long water-trucking project, providing water to families in Mogadishu, with each family receiving **45 litres** of clean water each day. Around **6,000** people benefited from this project.

# SUDAN



## HEALTH

Human Appeal provided **200** families in the region of Al Damazine with high quality wheelchairs, ensuring family members living with disabilities can overcome any mobility challenges they face in their daily lives.

## WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We distributed over **1,000** hygiene kits to displaced families in Omdurman. The kits included essential items such as sanitary pads, buckets, slippers, flashlights, washing powder, toothbrushes, and jerry cans for water collection.

## FOOD SECURITY

Collaborating with our partners **INNOCENTS**, we distributed **171** food parcels to families in Omdurman. Each parcel contained essentials like cooking oil, rice, lentils, tea and sugar, helping families meet their basic needs.

## SPIRITUAL/WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



Human Appeal completed the construction of a mosque and a clean water well in Sandaf, northern Aleppo, providing **2,500** people with a place of worship and access to clean drinking water.

## WINTER



Human Appeal distributed **190** winter kits to families living in Al-Sabireen Camp, as well as Ahl Al-Kahf and Al-Farouq Orphanages in Syria. Each winter kit contains winter clothes, boots, gloves, scarves and other items for keeping warm in the oncoming bitter cold months.

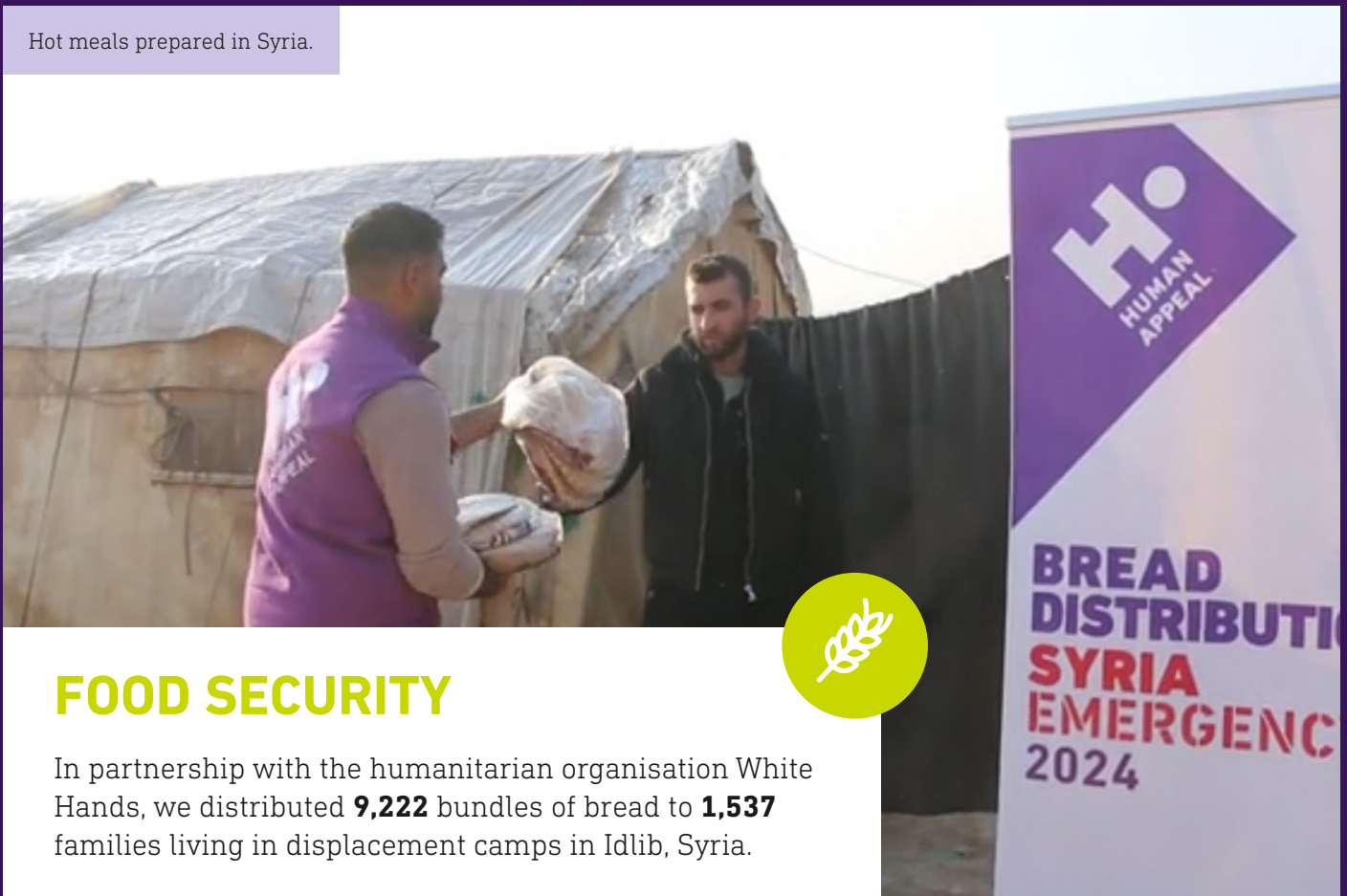


## WINTER

## FOOD SECURITY



In partnership with the humanitarian organisation White Hands, we distributed **9,222** bundles of bread to **1,537** families living in displacement camps in Idlib, Syria.

## EDUCATION



We hosted a back-to-school event at Al-Sabr School in Al-Zohoor village, one of the three villages where we have built brick homes for displaced Syrian families. We distributed school bags with supplies to **1,386** students.

# YEMEN

## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal provided **15** people living with disabilities with artificial limbs, enabling them to secure livelihoods and care for their families.
