MAY EDITION

In May, your generosity helped us bring hope, dignity, and relief to thousands of people across the globe. From providing vital medical care in Syria to ensuring children in Gaza can continue learning despite unimaginable hardships, your support made a powerful difference.

In Gaza, our teams delivered hot meals. bread, food parcels, clean water, and critical healthcare via our mobile clinics. We also provided fresh vegetables, firewood to protect against the cold, and ongoing education for children. In Iraq, we supported farmers with olive trees and essential agricultural tools, helping rebuild livelihoods.

In Pakistan, we celebrated World Bee Day by empowering beekeepers and responded to the rise in conflict by delivering food and blankets to families displaced. In Senegal, we partnered with the Papiss Demba Cissé Foundation to build lifesaving water wells and classrooms.

Across Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Togo, and Yemen, your compassion fuelled everything from clean water projects and medical aid to food security and livelihood development. Together, we are reaching every human.

FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **1,973 food parcels** to families in Gaza—reaching over **9,473 people** with essential food staples.



FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **1,611 bread bundles** to **1,611 families**, a total of around **7,551 people**.





HEALTH

Our mobile clinics in Gaza provided care to **1,084 patients** over the course of May.



EDUCATION

Human Appeal launched a "Let's Play and Learn" initiative at Abu Shamis shelter in Gaza, giving **75 children** a safe and fully equipped educational space where they can learn Arabic, English, science and numeracy.



EDUCATION

Human Appeal visited Habiba School in Dei al-Balah, Gaza, where **100 students** have a chance to learn both science and English.

FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **2,000 vegetable parcels**, containing tomatoes, cucumbers, onions, cauliflower, green peppers, and eggplants to **2,000 families**, a total of around **5,686 people**.





LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal provided **50 farmers** in the Nanaiwa Governorate with **105 olive tree saplings**, a complete irrigation system, and tools and training to cultivate them with.



LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal Pakistan celebrated World Bee Day 2025 in collaboration with the National Agricultural Research Centre. Beekeepers supported by Human Appeal showcased their honey at stalls attended by government officials, agricultural experts, and members of the public. Daud Saqlain, Country Director of Human Appeal Pakistan, highlighted the vital role of honeybees in environmental health and global food systems.









We are continuing to build four new classrooms at Marsassoum School, allowing more children to study there safely and easily.





EDUCATION

Human Appeal has successfully constructed **5 classrooms** for the Franco-Arab school in Sedhiou, also providing them with necessary furniture and equipment, and inaugurating the new classrooms.



















LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal provided chicken coops and training sessions on poultry farming to **60 people**. Each of the trainees will also receive **600 chicks**, along with sufficient chicken feed to feed them for a month and a half. So far, **25 people** have received the chicks.



LIVELIHOODS

We distributed three sheep each to **194 families** in Idlib and Aleppo, alongside the fodder to feed them. We also provided training sessions on sheep care to each family.
