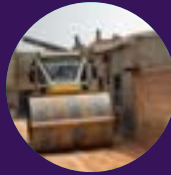

## WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP MAY EDITION

In May, your generosity helped us bring hope, dignity, and relief to thousands of people across the globe. From providing vital medical care in Syria to ensuring children in Gaza can continue learning despite unimaginable hardships, your support made a powerful difference.

In Gaza, our teams delivered hot meals, bread, food parcels, clean water, and critical healthcare via our mobile clinics. We also provided fresh vegetables, firewood to protect against the cold, and ongoing education for children. In Iraq, we supported farmers with olive trees and essential agricultural tools, helping rebuild livelihoods.

In Pakistan, we celebrated World Bee Day by empowering beekeepers and responded to the rise in conflict by delivering food and blankets to families displaced. In Senegal, we partnered with the Papiss Demba Cissé Foundation to build life-saving water wells and classrooms.

Across Somalia, Sudan, Syria, Togo, and Yemen, your compassion fuelled everything from clean water projects and medical aid to food security and livelihood development. Together, we are reaching every human.

## FOOD SECURITY

In May, we provided **158,717 hot meals** in Gaza, supporting over **17,068 families**.

## FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **1,973 food parcels** to families in Gaza—reaching over **9,473 people** with essential food staples.

## FOOD SECURITY

We distributed **1,611 bread bundles** to **1,611 families**, a total of around **7,551 people**.



## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We distributed **324,993 litres** of clean drinking water in Gaza, providing it to **9,873 families (50,319 people)**.

## HEALTH

Our mobile clinics in Gaza provided care to **1,084 patients** over the course of May.

## EDUCATION

Human Appeal launched a "Let's Play and Learn" initiative at Abu Shamis shelter in Gaza, giving **75 children** a safe and fully equipped educational space where they can learn Arabic, English, science and numeracy.

## EDUCATION



Human Appeal visited Habiba School in Dei al-Balah, Gaza, where **100 students** have a chance to learn both science and English.

## FOOD SECURITY



We distributed **2,000 vegetable parcels**, containing tomatoes, cucumbers, onions, cauliflower, green peppers, and eggplants to **2,000 families**, a total of around **5,686 people**.

## SHELTER



Human Appeal distributed several tons of firewood to families in the north of Gaza, providing them with enough firewood to last them a month to protect families from the cold.

## LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal provided **50 farmers** in the Nanaiwa Governorate with **105 olive tree saplings**, a complete irrigation system, and tools and training to cultivate them with.

## LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal Pakistan celebrated World Bee Day 2025 in collaboration with the National Agricultural Research Centre. Beekeepers supported by Human Appeal showcased their honey at stalls attended by government officials, agricultural experts, and members of the public. Daud Saqlain, Country Director of Human Appeal Pakistan, highlighted the vital role of honeybees in environmental health and global food systems.

## EMERGENCY RESPONSE



In the wake of recent escalations in Pakistan, Human Appeal provided **350 families** in the Haveli district with emergency response kits that included both food packs and blankets.

## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

In partnership with the Papiss Demba Cissé Foundation, we constructed six new water wells in the Fatik and Thies regions, transforming daily life for around **1,350 people**.

## EDUCATION

We are continuing to build four new classrooms at Marsassoum School, allowing more children to study there safely and easily.

## EDUCATION

Human Appeal has successfully constructed **5 classrooms** for the Franco-Arab school in Sedhiou, also providing them with necessary furniture and equipment, and inaugurating the new classrooms.



# SOMALIA

## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Four rural Somali villages now have access to clean, drinkable water thanks to newly built wells, benefitting approximately **4,800 people**.

## FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal has performed **128 Aqiqa sacrifices** in 2025 so far, providing **512 families** with 3kg of meat each.

## WASH

Over **2,000 non-food item kits** were distributed to families returning to Madani, helping them restore a sense of cleanliness and dignity as they rebuild.





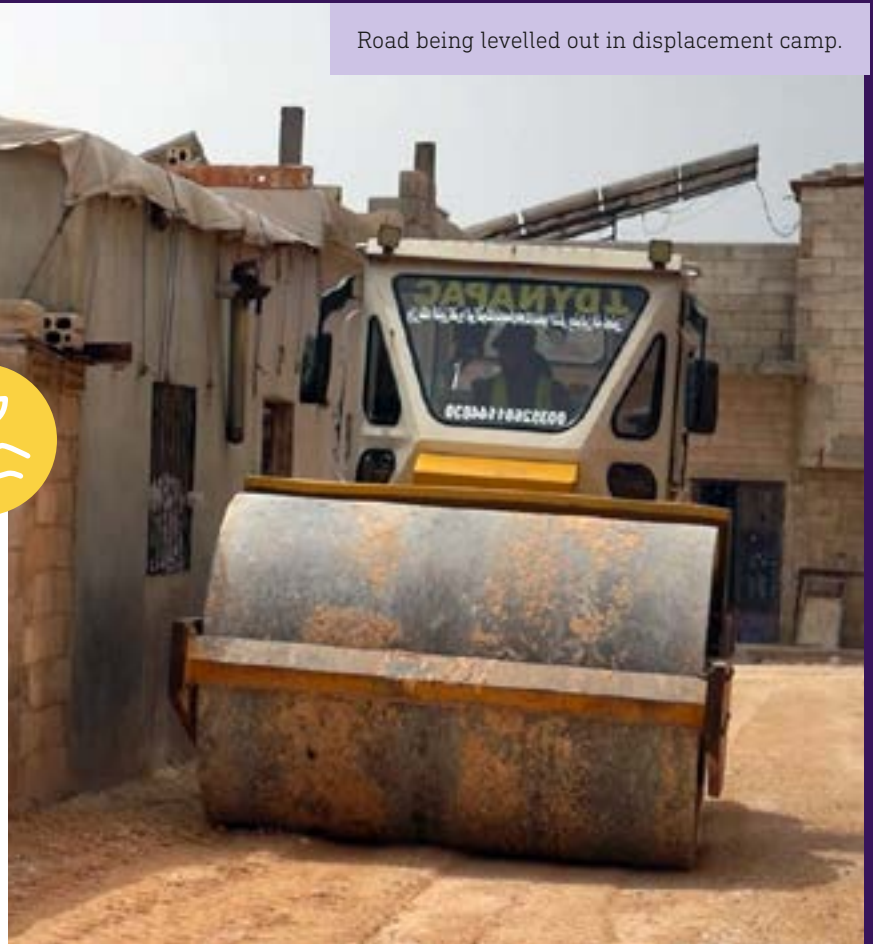

## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal has made several infrastructure improvements in the camps of Killi and Deir Hassan, including fire response rooms, solar powered-lights and road and tent rehabilitation, making the camps safer and more secure for all their residents.



## HEALTH



Al Iman Hospital provided medical care to **5,013 patients** over the course of April, providing paediatric, gynaecological and obstetric care, as well as new sessions to deal with gender-based violence and psychological support.



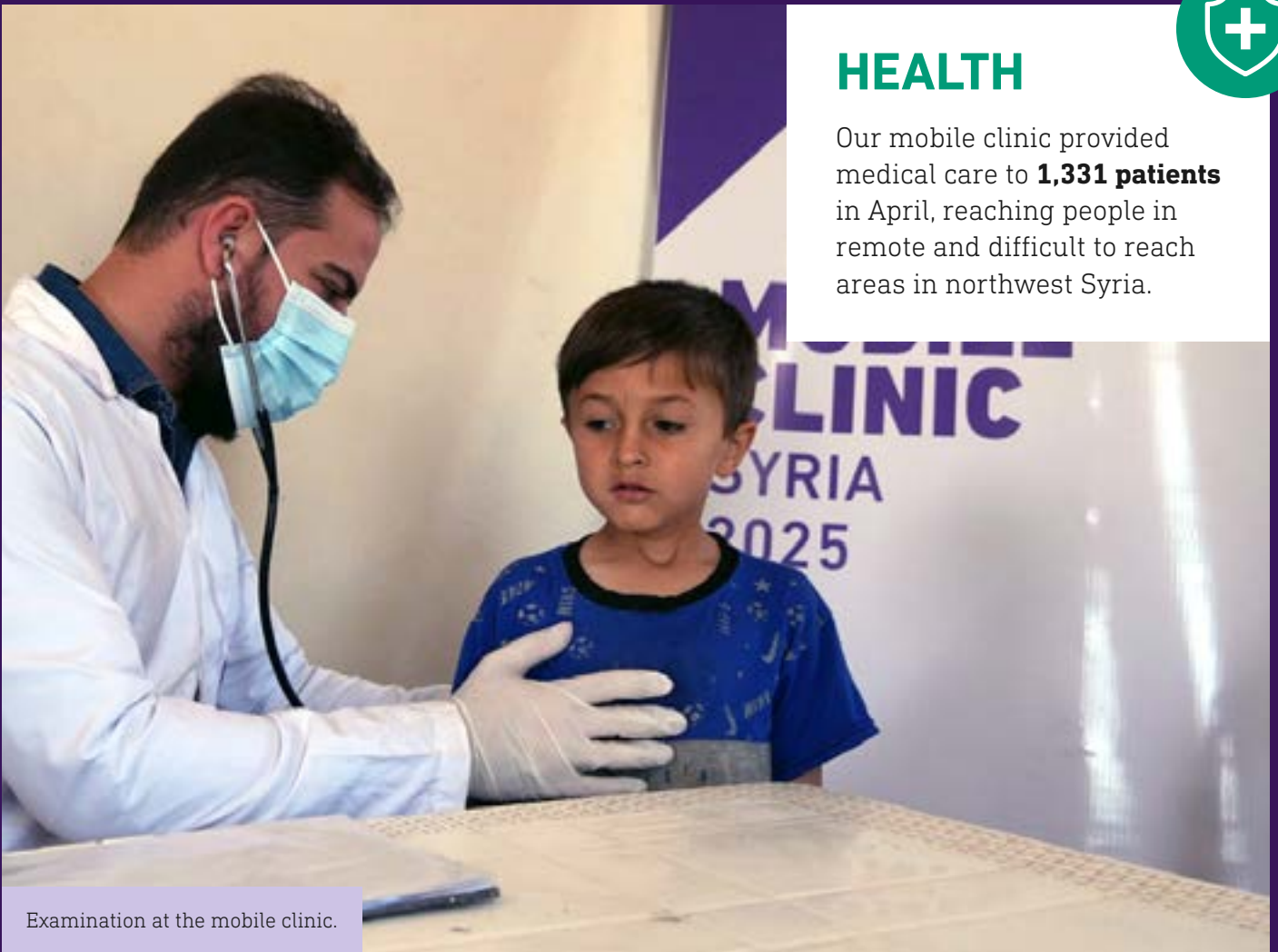

## HEALTH

Our mobile clinic provided medical care to **1,331 patients** in April, reaching people in remote and difficult to reach areas in northwest Syria.

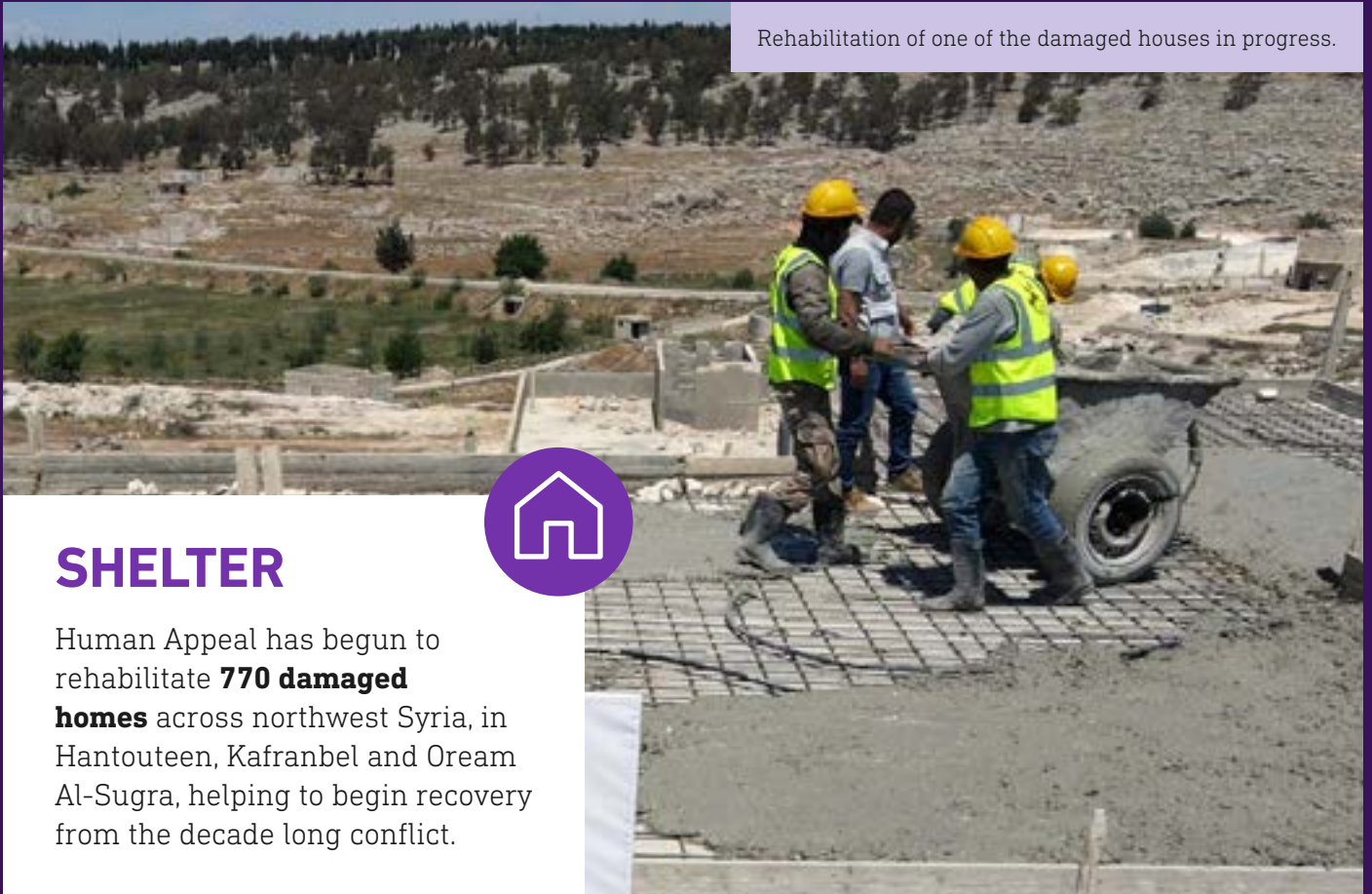

## HEALTH

The Al Zohoor Health Centre has provided critical medical care to **5,367 patients** over the course of April, who benefited from the centre's many clinics, including a dental clinic, a gynaecology clinic and a paediatric clinic.

Rehabilitation of one of the damaged houses in progress.

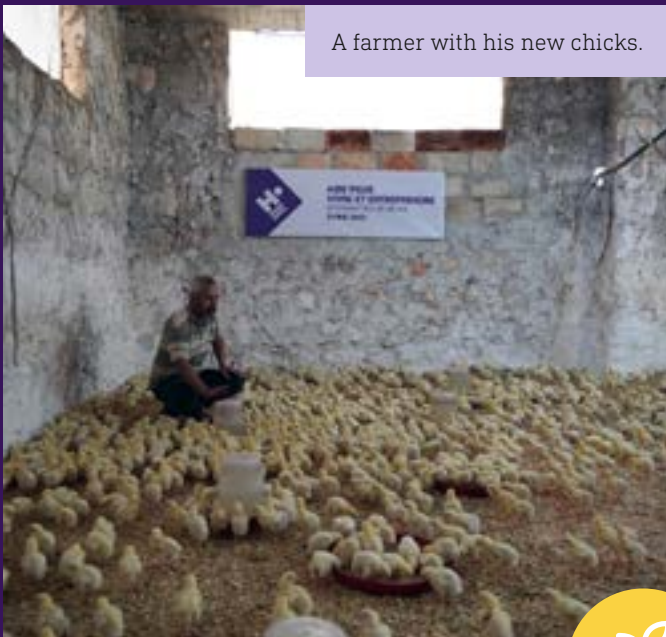


## SHELTER



Human Appeal has begun to rehabilitate **770 damaged homes** across northwest Syria, in Hantouteen, Kafranbel and Oream Al-Sugra, helping to begin recovery from the decade long conflict.

## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal provided chicken coops and training sessions on poultry farming to **60 people**. Each of the trainees will also receive **600 chicks**, along with sufficient chicken feed to feed them for a month and a half. So far, **25 people** have received the chicks.

## LIVELIHOODS



We distributed three sheep each to **194 families** in Idlib and Aleppo, alongside the fodder to feed them. We also provided training sessions on sheep care to each family.

## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We have completed the construction of three deep water wells in villages in Togo, and almost completed a fourth. Each well provides clean water to around **500 people**, for a total of **2,000 people**.

## FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal is working to distribute bread to **3,430 families**, with each family receiving **45 loaves of bread**, supporting a total of **24,010 people**.
