OCTOBER EDITION

In October, our commitment to humanity persisted on multiple fronts. In response to the earthquakes in Afghanistan, Human Appeal provided crucial aid – meals, drinking water, and tents. In Gaza, our hands-on emergency response included distributing hot meals, food parcels, and hygiene kits. We brightened the lives of Gaza's children with a fun day amid challenging times.

In Pakistan, the Aaminah Centre stands as a beacon for street children, and we've equipped various schools with water coolers to ensure children have access to clean water. The cataract campaign in Somalia successfully assisted over a thousand individuals, complemented by educational initiatives on handwashing for children.

Syria witnessed progress in Al Yasameen village, alongside ongoing efforts at Al Zohoor and Mashhad Ruhin Health Centres, contributing to countless lives saved. Al Imaan Hospital celebrated the arrival of over 400 newborns. In preparation for continued healthcare support, Human Appeal is gearing up to distribute medical containers.

Yemen experienced positive changes with the completion of a solar-powered water well in a village and the rehabilitation of two schools, providing children with a conducive learning environment. Human Appeal's dedication to global well-being remains unwavering.

AFGHANISTAN



EMERGENCY RESPONSE

After the disastrous earthquakes that struck Afghanistan, Human Appeal was on the ground, supporting affected families with hot meals, drinking water and tents for temporary shelter. In just two days, we provided affected families with over **1,150 hot meals and water**.



GAZA

In the midst of the tragic humanitarian crisis in Gaza that began this month on the 7th, faced with almost daily bombings and a near total lockdown, even of aid, Human Appeal's team in Gaza is still trying it's best to provide daily aid to the people of Gaza. Human Appeal was founded in 1991 to provide humanitarian aid in Gaza, and we have never forgotten our roots.







EMERGENCY

We distributed **50 hygiene kits** and **50 food parcels** to families that have been displaced by the bombings.

EMERGENCY

We have distributed hot meals, food parcels, hygiene kits and clean water to families in Gaza.





CHILD WELFARE

In partnership with Search for Justice and in coordination with the Child Protection Bureau in Punjab, Human Appeal launched the Aaminah Learning and Protection Centre in Shahdara, a suburb of Lahore known for its significant population of street children. This centre offers complimentary basic literacy and numeracy classes for **two hours** each day. Additionally, it provides free training courses in beautician and sewing skills for young women, empowering them to build sustainable livelihoods.

To address the mental well-being of the children, the centre has a dedicated child psychologist offering assessments and counselling. Furthermore, a general physician conducts weekly visits to provide free medical consultations and dispense necessary medicines to the local community. The Aaminah Learning and Protection Centre stands as a holistic initiative catering to the educational, vocational, and health needs of the vulnerable population in the area.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

Human Appeal donated a total of **18 water coolers** to various governmental schools in the area of Taxila, providing students with filtered water that is safe to drink.


SOMALIA

HEALTH

The successful culmination of the cataract surgery campaign in Somalia surpasses its set goals for both cataract surgeries and consultations for eye diseases. Across three hospitals, we extended our services to 6,224 patients, delivering essential consultations and treatments. Notably, 1,011 patients received life-changing cataract surgeries, contributing to improved vision and enhanced quality of life for individuals in need.

SYRIA

SHELTER

Ongoing progress is observed in Al Yasameen village, Maarat Misrin, as groundwork is laid for future construction. The village is set to comprise **250 housing units**, each accommodating four homes, resulting in a total of **1,000 houses**. This inclusive development plan also encompasses the establishment of a sewage system and a drinking water network. Presently, **680 houses** have been successfully completed, with **320** of them having already received roofing. Notably, construction is advancing at a rate of approximately **120 houses** per week. The collective efforts aim to create a thriving and sustainable community in Al Yasameen village.

HEALTH

Over the month of September, Al Zohoor Healthcare Centre, set up in collaboration with Americares, received approximately **5,659 patients** following displacement and heavy bombing in the Idlib region. The team underwent specialised training in Gender-Based Violence and psychological first aid to enhance the provision of psychological support services to individuals affected by these challenges.

HEALTH



Masshad Rouhin Health Centre has provided free healthcare to **5,929 patients** over the course of the last month, an increased number following heavy bombing and displacement in the Idlib countryside. A dental clinic is also being set up in the Masshad Rouhin Health Centre to meet the need.

HEALTH

Al Imaan Hospital delivered **354 babies** conventionally over the course of October, and performed **73 Caesarean surgeries**. It also provided care to **5,644 beneficiaries**, following the closure of several other hospitals in the area.
An expansion of the hospital is also being planned.





HEALTH

Human Appeal has received medical containers from Globus Relief, which will support at least **50 healthcare** facilities across northwest Syria.



YEMEN

EDUCATION

Human Appeal rehabilitated Ali Bin Abi Taleb School in Sana'a Govenorate. The rehabilitation of this three-floor building involved painting the interior and exterior, repairing broken windows, installing new classroom doors, providing new desks for students, replacing old whiteboards and improving the roofing.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

A solar-powered deep water well was established at a village in the Sanaa Governorate, with **120 solar panels** helping to power the well.

Human Appeal inaugurated the further construction of Al Salaam School in Taiz Governorate, making it easier for children in Shara'ab district to go to school and learn. In addition to rehabilitating the first floor of the school, we built a second floor, so the school can take more students.
