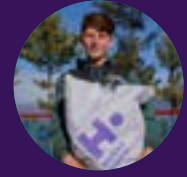

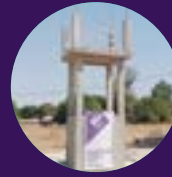

YEMEN

WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP JANUARY EDITION

In January 2025, we continued our mission to support people in need across multiple regions. In Gaza, we provided hot meals, food parcels, clean water, and medical care to residents. We also distributed winter clothes and firewood to help them stay warm, cleared rubble from roads, and established temporary schools so children could resume their education. In Iraq, we trained women in rural areas on beekeeping and distributed livestock to farmers. In Lebanon, we delivered essential medicine and food parcels, and provided families with vouchers to purchase winter clothes. In Morocco, we distributed medical supplies to remote areas, and in Pakistan, we provided families with winter kits to help them stay warm.

Our emergency response in Senegal included food parcels, hygiene kits, mattresses, blankets, and mosquito nets for families in need. In Sudan, we built hundreds of shelters and

provided families with hygiene kits. In Syria, we distributed bread, heating fuel, and school uniforms and shoes for children. We also received medical supplies for hospitals, offered vocational training to help people establish livelihoods, and constructed permanent shelters for nearly two hundred families. Our medical services continue to provide care across Syria.

Additionally, we have started building water wells in Togo and have organized cataract surgeries and delivered medical supplies in Yemen.

For winter, we are distributing 200kg of olive pomace to 2,400 displaced families in the villages of Al Zohoor and Al Yasameen in Syria, ensuring they have the fuel needed to stay warm. These villages were built by Human Appeal, and we continue to support the families living there.

HEALTH

Over January, our mobile clinics provided medical aid to **516 patients**.



FOOD SECURITY

We delivered **159 food** parcels in Gaza, providing families with food items such as rice, sugar, tomato paste, olive oil and jam, amongst others.

We distributed **316,487 hot meals** in Gaza, to **65,725 families**.

WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We distributed **828,000 litres** of clean drinking water to **30,197 families**, supporting **151,516 people**.

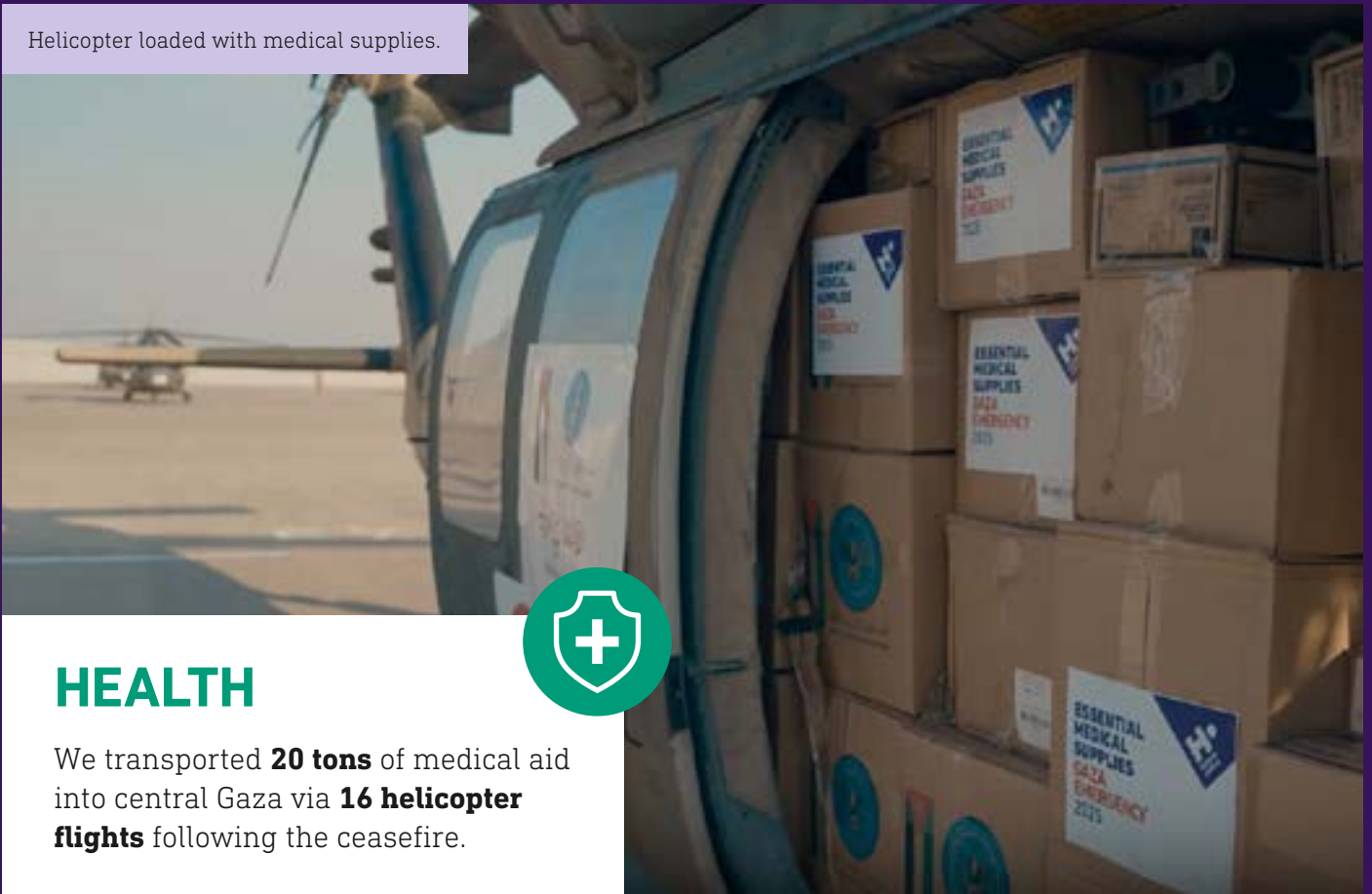


EDUCATION

HEALTH



We transported **20 tons** of medical aid into central Gaza via **16 helicopter flights** following the ceasefire.

WINTER



We distributed firewood to families in Gaza, distributing a total of **35 tons of firewood to 170 families**. Each family received **200kg of firewood**, providing warmth to approximately **850 people**.



EMERGENCY/LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal is leading rubble-clearing operations in Rafah, opening up vital roads and helping the people of Gaza recover after over one year of war.

SHELTER

We are clearing a region in Gaza in preparation for building a displacement camp for families in Gaza who have lost their homes.

FOOD SECURITY



Human Appeal delivered **3,360 chicken shawarmas** to children in Gaza, donated by Shelby's Canada.

WINTER



We distributed clothes to **46 families**, a total of **235 people**.

IRAQ



LIVELIHOODS

We provided **30 women** from rural areas in Iraq with training on beekeeping and honey production techniques. We also provided equipment and supplies to the trainees, including providing each with six beehives.

LIVELIHOODS

We distributed livestock to **95 farmers** in Iraq, providing each family with **5 sheep** and enough fodder to feed them for three months.



LIVELIHOODS

We provided **400 people** with **40-day job** training programmes, including both vocational training and “on-the-job” training, in areas such as automobile repair, beekeeping, media, education, construction, and dental clinic work, among others.

LEBANON

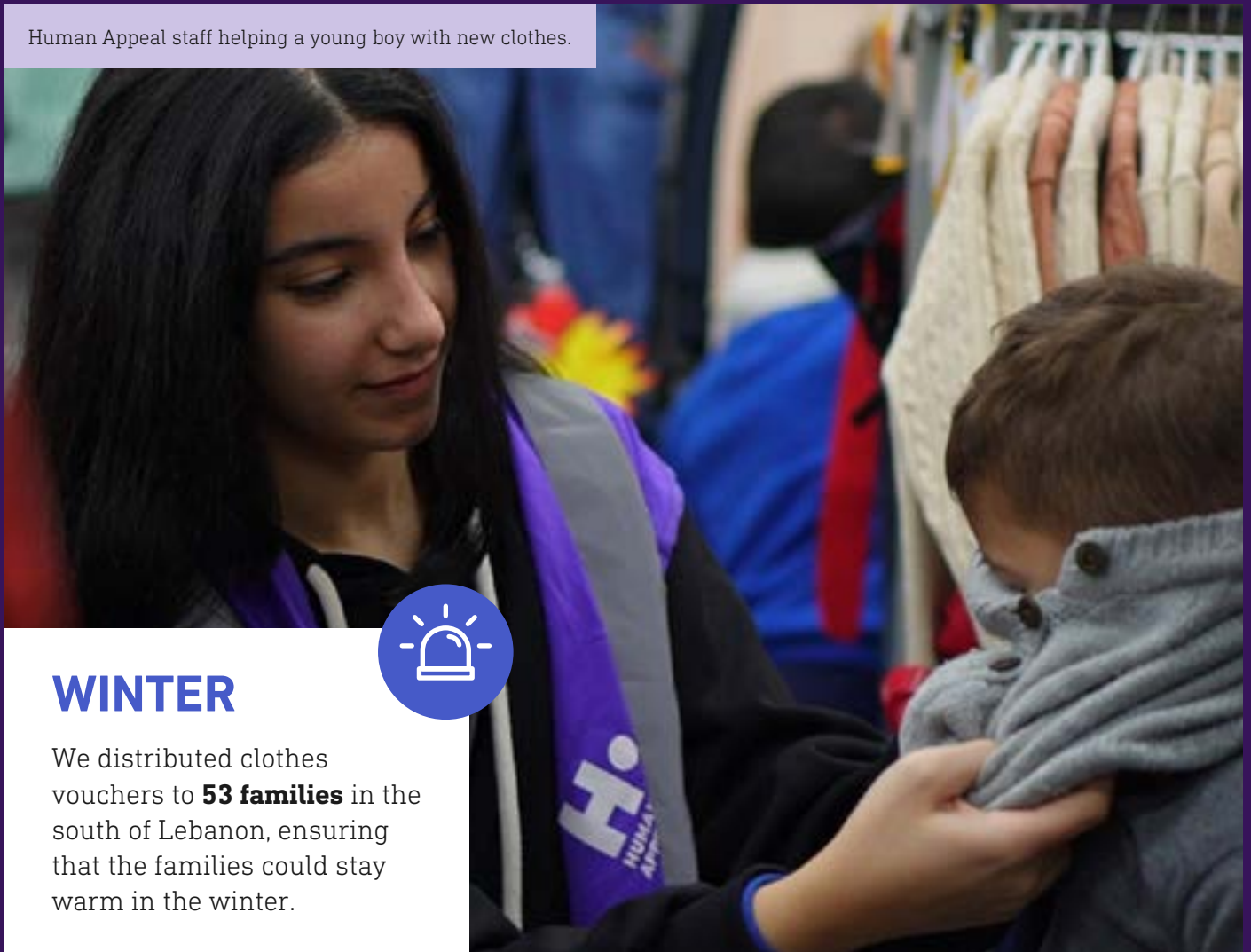

Human Appeal has distributed **3,150** essential medicines to six health centres across North Lebanon, supporting Lebanon's healthcare infrastructure.

WINTER



Human Appeal Pakistan distributed **850 winter kits** across Pakistan. Each kit contained two shawls, two sweaters, four pairs of socks, two knitted caps, two scarves and four pairs of gloves.

SENEGAL

EMERGENCY RESPONSE



Human Appeal distributed **100 food parcels, 100 hygiene kits, 100 mattresses, 100 blankets** and **300 mosquito nets** to families affected by the floods in the city of Ngodiba.

WASH (WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



Human Appeal is setting up water points in remote, rural villages, ensuring around **1,860 people** will have access to clean and sustainable water.

SHELTER/WASH



Human Appeal set over **600 shelters** for families in Gedarif State, with each family also receiving a hygiene kit of non-food items that included both everyday essentials for hygiene and jerry cans to store water in.

FOOD SECURITY



Human Appeal distributed hundreds of fresh meals to patients of Alnow Hospital, as well as their families, ensuring they receive the care and nourishment they need.

SYRIA

FOOD SECURITY



Human Appeal completed the distribution of **over 20,000** bundles of bread to families who remain internally displaced in Syria.

HEALTH



Human Appeal Syria received four containers of medical supplies from Globus Relief. They are currently being sorted, and will be distributed to major hospitals across northwestern Syria once they have been organised.

WINTER



Human Appeal is distributing 200kg of olive pomace to **2,400** displaced families in Al Zohoor and Al Yasameen in Syria, two of the villages Human Appeal built, ensuring these families have the fuel needed to stay warm.

LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal is providing vocational training to **200 trainees** in Al Zohoor village, in fields such as phone maintenance, accessory making, pastry making, and detergent production.



SHELTER

Human Appeal constructed **199** permanent shelters/homes for displaced families living in Al-Nashmi and Al-Hourani displacement camps in the north of Idlib. These permanent shelters are planned to also have access to sanitation systems, running water and electricity.

EDUCATION



Human Appeal distributed clothes and shoes to **1,386 children** who attend Al-Sabr School in Al Zohoor as part of the Back to School campaign.

Our healthcare centre in Al-Zohoor continues to see approximately **200 people** each day, benefiting from its many departments and free treatment.

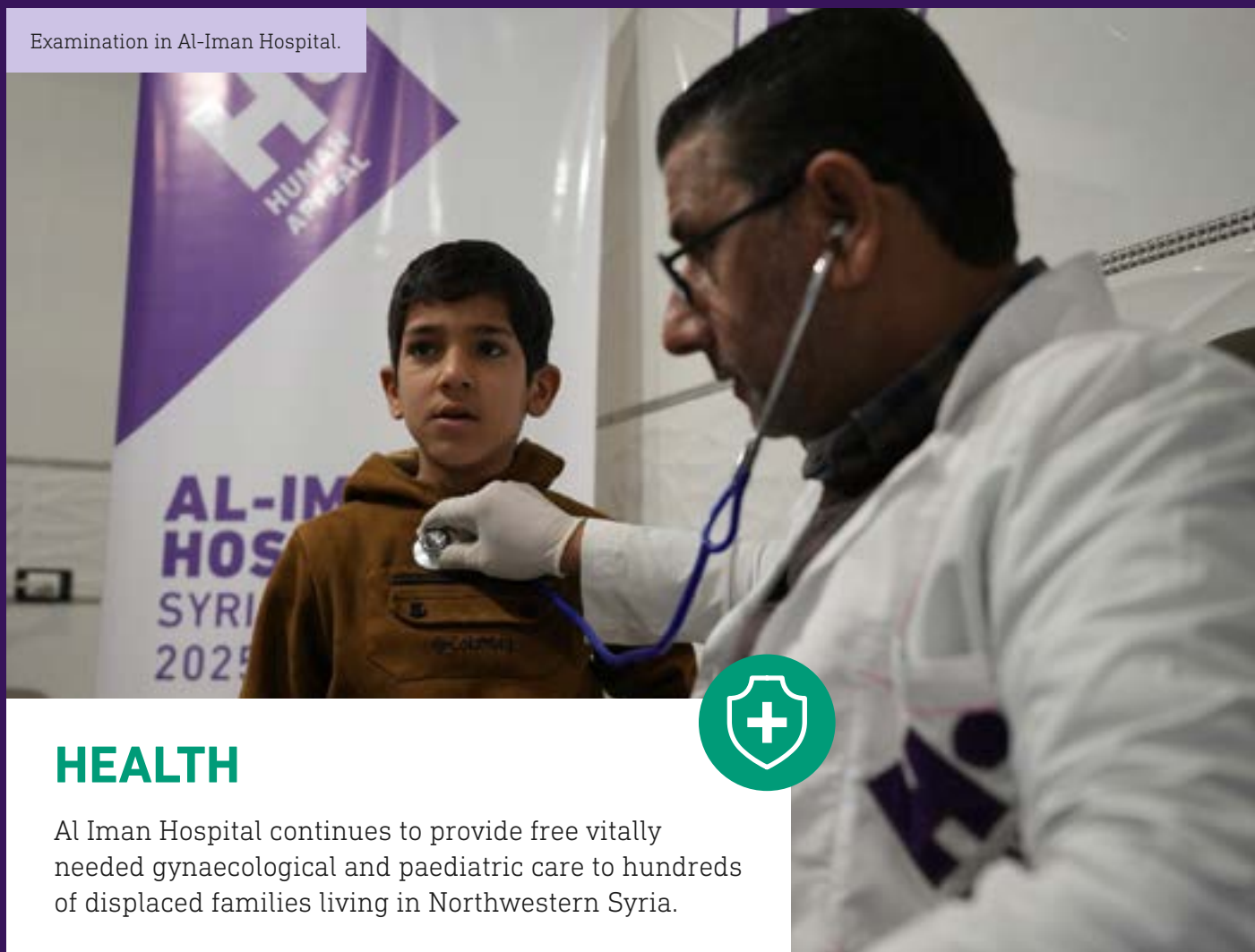

HEALTH

Our mobile clinic continues to operate in displacement camps throughout Northwestern Syria, providing people with access to a general physician, a gynaecological clinic and a community health worker.

TOGO

Construction has begun on four deep water wells in four rural villages in Togo, providing fresh, clean water to **2,000 people**.

YEMEN

HEALTH

Human Appeal performed cataract removal surgery for **700** people in the Baijl district, as well as the crucial follow-up care needed for successful recoveries.

HEALTH



Human Appeal worked alongside the Dr. Amin Nasher Highest Institute of Health Sciences to raise awareness about breast and cervical cancer. The campaign covered preventative measures, information on these forms of cancer, and how to detect them.
