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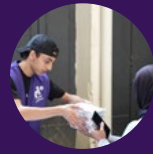
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WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP JULY EDITION

This July, your support turned into hot meals, clean water, and new skills for people across ten countries. Human Appeal reached people in Bangladesh, Gaza, Kenya, Lebanon, Pakistan, Senegal, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen — providing hot meals, clean water that will serve communities for generations to come, and education to help children build better futures.

In Bangladesh, your support provided cooking fuel and hot meals for displaced Rohingya families, plus education support through our Street Children Centre. In Gaza, we provided hot meals, installed water desalination units,

and supported children through safe spaces and education. In Lebanon, we delivered hot meals and food parcels to families facing displacement. Sudan is where we're building long-term livelihoods — training women in in-demand trades, giving farmers tools and seeds, and providing daily clean water and bread. In Syria, we're preparing for the future, offering vocational training in skills like beekeeping, and rehabilitating homes, schools and a water station. Alongside this, we've continued supporting communities in Kenya, Pakistan, Senegal, Somalia and Yemen.

Every drop of water, every hot meal, every lesson taught — made possible by you.

FOOD SECURITY



We distributed **213,900** meals to Rohingya refugees and to host communities, providing beef kabsa, chicken biryani, and beef porridge.

LIVELIHOODS



We trained **40** people on how to make soap bars, liquid hand wash, and liquid dish wash, including safety and technical training.

SHELTER



We distributed **392** Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) cylinders to use for cooking fuel, refilling the cylinders on a regular basis between April and August.

CHILD WELFARE



We are supporting **140** children living on the streets through the Street Children Centre. We provide meals, health care, education and more, including fun activities like organising football matches.

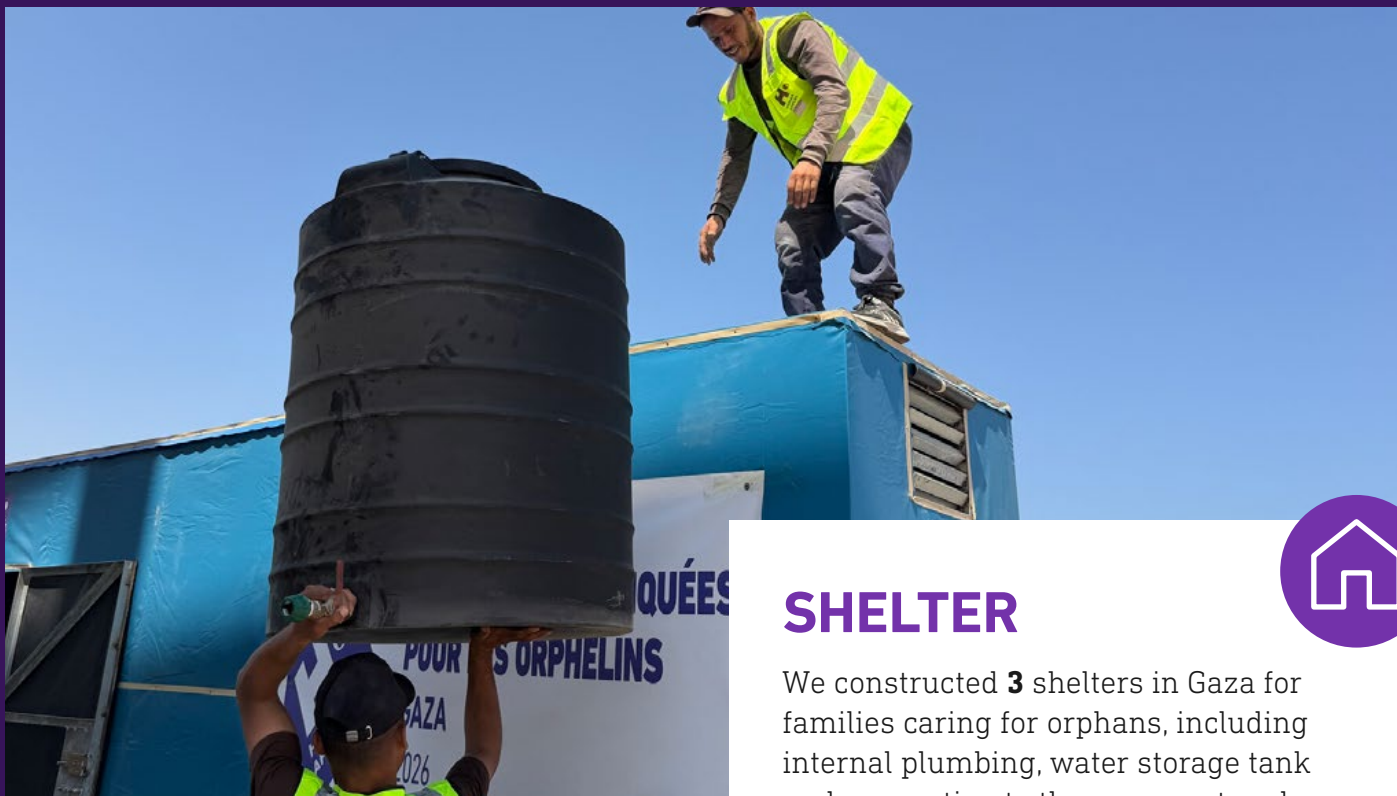
EDUCATION



We distributed **94** back-to-school kits to children, with each kit containing a rucksack, notebooks, stationery, a school bag, and other items like colouring books, to assist the children in school and lighten their hearts.

SHELTER



We constructed **3** shelters in Gaza for families caring for orphans, including internal plumbing, water storage tank and connection to the sewer network.

FOOD SECURITY



Distributed **53,000** hot meals in Gaza, providing families with warm and filling meals.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



We installed two **20m³** desalination units one at Sheik Hammad Hospital and one at the Friends of the Patient Hospital, providing both the hospitals and nearby households with clean, drinkable water.

CHILD WELFARE



We provided **76** children with a safe space for their mental health and wellbeing, offering psychosocial support and personal hygiene lessons, alongside 10 individual counselling sessions in total for those requiring specialist support.

HEALTH



The prosthetic limb project continues at Sheikh Hamad Hospital, providing prosthetics and rehabilitation to people who have been severely injured.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



We distributed over **348.55m³** of clean water, providing **16,666** families with access to clean and safe water.

LIVELIHOODS



Distributed **144** vouchers for clothing to families in Gaza, providing families caring for orphans with warmth and security.

KENYA



LIVELIHOODS

We distributed sheep to **400** families in Tana River County, with each family receiving **3** sheep.

LEBANON

FOOD SECURITY

Distributed **2,300** hot meals and **120** food parcels in Saida, supporting **871** families displaced from their homes.

MOROCCO



SHELTER



We have built **40** temporary housing units in Ounane, providing **40** families with a secure place to live in once final checks have been completed.

SENEGAL



FOOD SECURITY



We distributed **25** motorised fishing boats in three villages in Senegal, assisting fishermen and fisherwomen in their work and helping them to maintain their own livelihoods.

PAKISTAN

LIVELIHOODS

We provided the mother of Laiba, a young girl undergoing medical treatment, with a sewing machine and fabric so she can set up a home-based tailoring business to provide a stable source of income for the family.

Basti Emaan Clinic continues to provide essential healthcare to the local community, providing medical consultations, access to medicine and an ambulance service.

LIVELIHOODS

SOMALIA

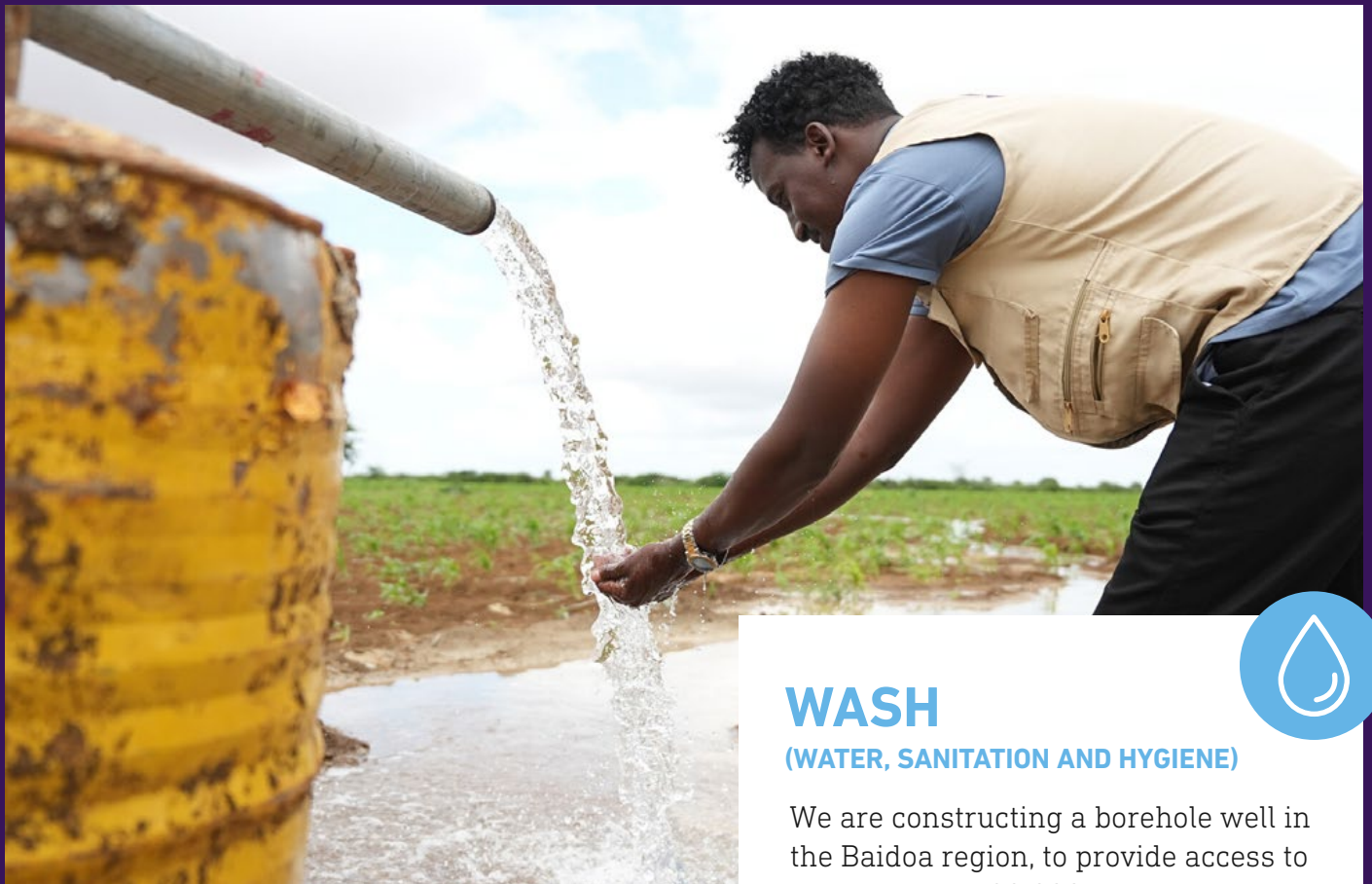

LIVELIHOODS



We provided vulnerable families in Mogadishu with pairs of goats and training on best practices for taking care of them, ensuring they had a source of nutrition and a way to enhance their livelihoods.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



We are constructing a borehole well in the Baidoa region, to provide access to clean water to **20,000** villagers.

SUDAN

LIVELIHOODS



We are training **120** women in Omdurman, Sudan on in-demand trades: sewing, perfume-making and baking, helping them to develop their skills and build their own livelihoods.

We distributed sorghum, millet seeds and farming tools to families in Blue Nile State, assisting **9,000** people with the ability to farm, harvest and build their own income.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We are distributing **22,500** litres of clean water in Sudan each day via water trucks.



EDUCATION



We have successfully rehabilitated five girls' schools in the Sharg AL-Jazeera region, providing **1,000** girls with classrooms to learn in, and training **50** teachers to provide vital education.

FOOD SECURITY



We are baking over **18,000** loaves each day in Khartoum, providing **1,700** families with bread.

SYRIA

LIVELIHOODS

Supported **100** people in Syria through training in practical skills, including pastry baking, mobile phone maintenance, solar panel installation and maintenance, and furniture construction and design. Of these, **50** participants also received in-kind grants to help them start their own businesses.

WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)

We have almost finished repairing the water station in Kafar Zita, installing a solar power system, repairing the water tank, and constructing a new station room.

We organised a "Parenting Under Pressure" session with Dr. Iman Bathika, in Damascus, providing mothers and caregivers with practical parenting approaches, positive communication techniques, and emotional wellbeing strategies for both children and caregivers.

LIVELIHOODS

Organised a beekeeping symposium in collaboration with Idlib's Directorate of Agriculture. The symposium discussed key challenges facing the beekeeping sector in the region, practical solutions and ways to strengthen support.

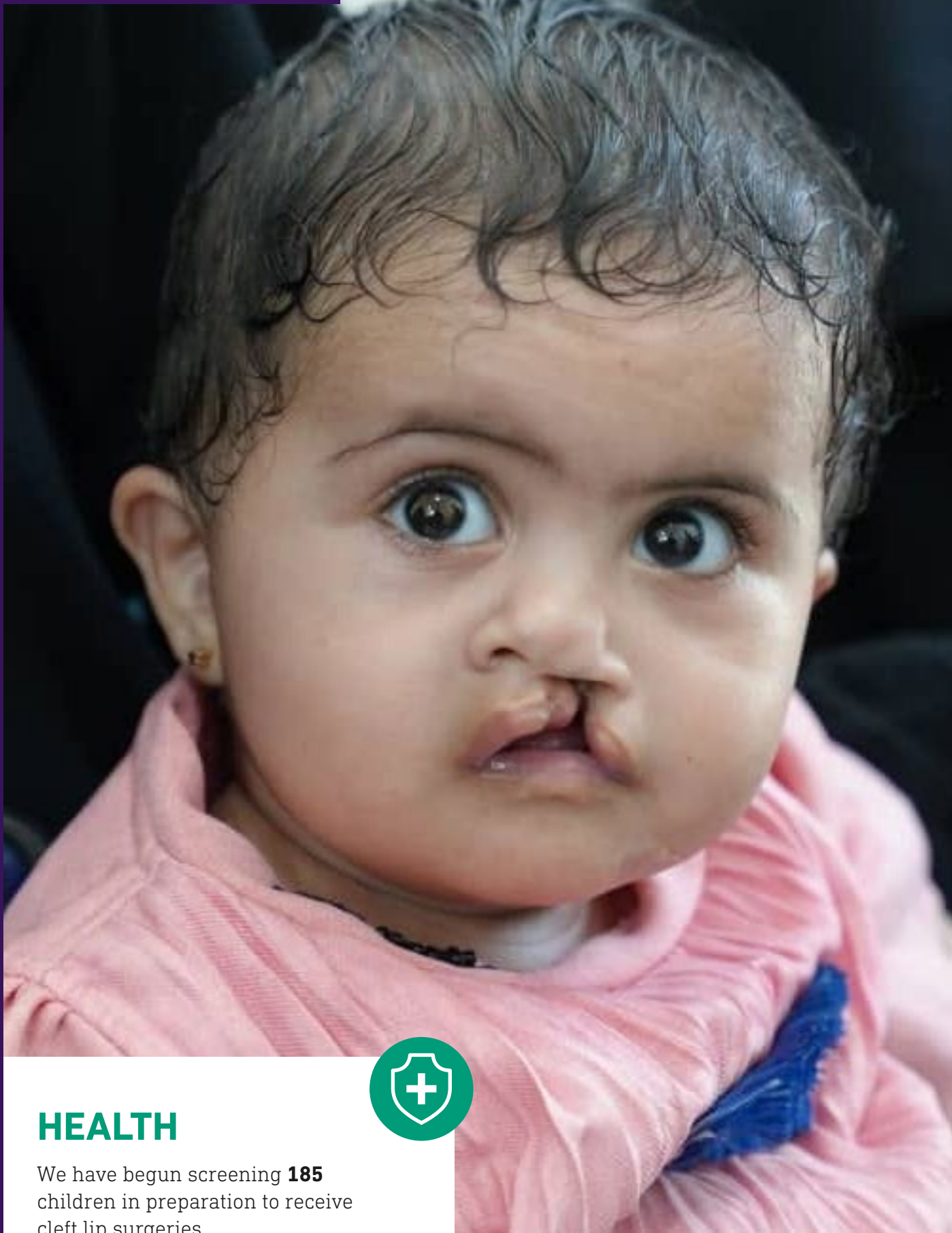
