In February, we provided **40,512 bottles** of hand sanitiser, which will be delivered to hospitals across Pakistan.

This month, we continued to provide critical medical supplies to the Indonesian Hospital in Gaza.

LIVELIHOODS:



In the first phase of our latest olive tree project, we provided **30,607 olive trees** to farmers in Gaza in collaboration with the Palestinian Hydrology Group, helping a total of **4,800 people**.

SHARING OUR WARMTH IN WINTER

Salman Abu Riji, his wife, and their seven children live in a tent near the playground where he works as a guard.

“The general situation is very bad. The ceiling is made of wood and covered in blankets. There is no kitchen, no rooms, and the bathroom is about 80 metres away. There are two tents, and in one tent is the kitchen and the fireplace. In winter, my children get sick when I light a fire because smoke fills the tent. The water floods into our home, there is no door and the blankets sink with water from the ceiling. My children have no suitable clothes and they get clothes from people.”

Human Appeal provided Salman with a heater and fuel, so his children did not have to go cold this winter. Thank you for helping us to spread warmth this winter.

This month, we delivered PPE to three hospitals in Mogadishu, Somalia, in partnership with Americares.

HEALTH

We distributed **274 atomizers** and **40 oxygen generators** to hospitals, isolation centres and other medical facilities throughout Syria. We also inaugurated our oxygen station in Sarmada, Idlib, which provides free oxygen to COVID-19 patients and serves **40%** of the local population.

Lifesaving healthcare to Naija

CHANGING LIVES WITH MOBILE CLINICS

58-year-old Naija fled her home in Hawran, Syria.

“Now I live in a cold tent in Sarmada. I have four children, three of them married, and I live with one of them. I have high blood pressure and need rest and calm, but everything I see here causes me to grieve. We live in poverty – there’s no work for my son, and we cannot acquire the basic necessities of life. I cannot afford the medicine I need.

“Alhamdulillah, Human Appeal’s mobile clinics visit our camp and provide us with medicine for free. A doctor gives me free medical examinations, and a nurse measures my hypertension. I am truly grateful to have these people with us here.

“There are very sick children and pregnant women here, and people who are injured and need first aid because the hospital is very far away. I can forget my pain when I see people doing good, helping those in urgent need. I am really grateful to them, for they provide services that we desperately need.”

EDUCATION

We're providing basic literacy and numeracy lesson in braille to help **4 Syrian refugees**, and **3 Turkish students** to access education in Turkish, Maths, and Science.

HEALTH

We're providing solar panels, fridges, and water tanks to **six health units** and a health centre near Taiz, helping **40,000 people** in **29 villages**.

In February, we continued our winter work in Yemen by distributing blankets, heaters, tea, and sugar to **100 families**. We also provided **20 blankets** and jackets to homeless people.
