# WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP APRIL EDITION

Over April and March, we continued to help every human as Ramadan came to a close. In Gaza, we continued to support the people of Palestine with food parcels over Shawwal, and our mobile clinic continues to support and assist injured Palestinians. Trucks containing medical supplies entered in Gaza in March, and we continued to distribute hot meals as we organised the entry of vitally needed food parcels into Gaza. In Iraq, we trained farmers in olive tree farming and provided them with saplings. In Pakistan, we completed construction on hundreds of homes, which were visited by the Pakistan country director. In Somalia, we provided nutritional support to malnourished children. In Syria, we distributed fuel to use as heating, organised recreational activities for children, completed construction of a water well and water tank in Al-Yasameen village and organised camp management projects. In addition, our treatment centre in Al-Zohoor continues to serve the community, as we provided vaccinations and distributed fresh bread in March. In Yemen, we began to construct a bakery to provide fresh bread to orphans.

## FOOD SECURITY



In the Deir al-Balah displacement camp, Human Appeal distributed **1,267 food parcels**, supporting **5,500 residents** who have been displaced from their homes. These food parcels support families struggling to make ends meet as the conflict in Gaza continues.

## HEALTH



Human Appeal's mobile clinic in Gaza has assisted a total of around **2,200** displaced people, visiting a different shelter school each week.

## EMERGENCY RESPONSE



On the 25th of April, we distributed **10,000 hot meals** to people who needed support in the central area of Gaza.

## HEALTH

In March, Human Appeal in Gaza received three trucks filled with essential medical aid via the Rafah border crossing. Including items like surgical masks, wheelchairs, medicine and more, these items were, and remain, badly needed by the limited medical facilities in Gaza.

## HEALTH

During Ramadan, our mobile clinic visited a shelter school in Rafah where **510 displaced families** have found refuge. It provided free consultations and medication to **70 patients** each day, as well as providing paediatric and gynaecological services and supporting those with chronic diseases such as diabetes or high blood pressure with vital medication.



## FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal has received **10,268 food parcels** via the Rafah crossing, which will be distributed to families in need inside shelter schools and other areas where the displaced congregate, as more than a million people take refuge in the south of Gaza.

## LIVELIHOODS



In Iraq, Human Appeal is training **600 farmers** in olive tree care, and providing them with **50 olive tree saplings** and the equipment they need to maintain them.

# PAKISTAN



## LIVELIHOODS



Human Appeal Pakistan's Country director, Daud Saqlain, visited the villages of Ghulam Hussain Chandio and Catay Di Miyani to appreciate the work done by our field staff in the course of our Pakistan Shelter Project. **324 flood resilient homes** were built in these villages. Daud also visited multiple solar-powered water filtration plants, and planted plants in the villages.

# SOMALIA



## HEALTH

We performed nutritional support in a community of displaced families in Mogadishu, identifying children who are severely malnourished and providing them with treatment with Ready-to-use Therapeutic Food.

# SYRIA



## WINTER

Human Appeal distributed beren, a type of olive oil byproduct used as fuel for heating, to families struggling with the high price of fuel and firewood. The beren distributed will help **995 people** stay warm through the cold.

## CHILD WELFARE



Human Appeal Syria organised recreational activities for children in displacement camps and in the orphan village, brightening the day of **450 children**.

## HEALTH



The treatment centre in Al-Zohoor village, one of the shelter villages set up by Human Appeal, continues to serve large numbers of patients from both Al Zohoor village and surrounding displacement camps. The centre, which includes several departments and a psychosocial support clinic, receives around **250 patients** each day, providing free treatment to all of them.

## WASH

(WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE)



Human Appeal dug a water well and constructed a water tank for Al-Yasameen, one of the villages Human Appeal has built in Syria for displaced families. In addition, we have begun building **500 additional houses** to the **1,000** already constructed, expanding Al-Yasameen to **1,500 houses**.

## CHILD WELFARE



Human Appeal has begun a camp management and protection project in the displacement camps of northwestern Syria, aiming to provide increased and equitable access to specialised services to thousands of children, as well as holding various awareness sessions, assistance and advice on parenting, and forming committees of volunteers. This project will support a total of **32,753 people** in Syria.

## FOOD SECURITY



Human Appeal successfully distributed fresh bread to around **711 families** each day across two displacement camps, from the beginning of 2024 until the end of March. The provision of bread has been a major benefit to families in the targeted camps, providing them with much needed nutrients they would otherwise struggle to afford.

## HEALTH



During March, Human Appeal Syria provided vaccines to over **200 children** each week in displacement camps in the Sarmada region, ensuring children in remote areas would be better able to resist diseases like polio, measles or smallpox, which could prove especially life-threatening as they lack access to healthcare.
