
# QURBANI 2022

Each year, after Ramadan comes to a close, our teams around the world begin to prepare for the blessed first ten days of Dhul Hijjah, which culminates in Muslims around the world sacrificing an animal, providing nutritious meat to vulnerable people during Eid al-Adha. Our teams work diligently on securing healthy, cared-for animals from local farmers, and preparing safe, organised distributions so that our supporters can provide value-for-money, nutritious meat that boosts the local market, while supporting vulnerable people.

Qurbani is an act of devotion that continues the legacy of the prophet Ibrahim (AS), a legacy that was sealed by Muhammad

(PBUH), who sacrificed two animals each Eid al-Adha. When he was asked what Qurbani is, the Messenger (PBUH) answered, **“It is the Sunnah of your father Ibrahim. For every hair of the Qurbani you receive a reward from Allah.”** (Al-Tirmidhi)

Unimaginably, we found ourselves in 2022, a year of even more crisis, but our supporters provided a staggering 328,989 people with fresh, nutritious meat. That's 61,192 families that you helped to support with fresh, nutritious meat, allowing them to celebrate Eid al-Adha.

# AFGHANISTAN

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Afghanistan in 2022 provided over **17 kilograms** of meat, split between **5 to 6 families**.



Decades of conflict and political turmoil, as well as economic instability has put a strain on Afghanistan's already limited resources. More than **24 million** people are in need of humanitarian help – that's more than half the total population.

But with your help, Human Appeal provided fresh, nutritious meat to **8,687** people in Wardek, Paktika.

In all, your donations provided **31** cows to **1,214** families. If you gave your Qurbani in Afghanistan last Dhul Hijjah, you provided an average of **17.14 kilograms** of beef — that's **3 kilograms** each to **5-6** vulnerable families, including families headed by women.

# BANGLADESH

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Bangladesh in 2022 provided over **11 kilograms** of meat, split between **3 to 4 families**.



In Bangladesh, nearly **174 million** people need humanitarian assistance, including **62 million** children. Families in Bangladesh have had to endure devastating floods, drought and hunger. Almost a third of Bangladeshis don't have enough to eat.

In 2022, your Qurbani charity provided **118** cows to **3,061** families in Jashore and Satkhira. If you gave your Qurbani in Bangladesh during Dhul Hijjah, you provided **11 kilograms** of beef — that's **3 kilograms** each to **3 to 4** vulnerable families, including families headed by women.

# INDIA

Each Qurbani sacrifice in India in 2022 provided over **14 kilograms** of meat, split between **3 families**.



India is currently facing the threat of climate change and rising COVID-19 cases, leaving **664 million** people in need of humanitarian assistance, including a devastating **286 million** children.

Last Dhul Hijjah, with your help, we provided **2,102** sacrifices to **42,040** families in Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and West Bengal. If you performed your Qurbani in India during Dhul Hijjah, you provided **14.3 kilograms** of beef or buffalo meat - that's **4.5 kilograms** of nutritious meat each to **3** vulnerable families.

# IRAQ

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Iraq in 2022 provided over **22 kilograms** of meat, split between **7 to 8** families.



After decades of conflict and instability in Iraq, **2.4 million** people need help to support their food or livelihoods. **1.2 million** people are still displaced and the devaluation of the Iraqi dinar has drastically affected families' ability to cope.

With your support last Qurbani, we provided **1,764** people with fresh nutritious mutton in Ninewa. If you gave your Qurbani in Iraq last Dhul Hijjah, you provided **22.3 kilograms** of mutton or lamb — that's **3 kilograms** each to **7 or 8** vulnerable families, including families headed by women.

# MALAWI

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Malawi in 2022 provided over **14 kilograms** of meat, split between **3** families.



An estimated **37%** of children in Malawi are stunted; almost a quarter of children's deaths are related to malnutrition. Malawi's economic security depends on agriculture but climate disasters including drought and flooding are making it increasingly difficult for farmers to make a living.

In 2022, with your support, we provided **4,573** people with fresh nutritious beef in Blantyre, Chiradzulu, Mangochi, Liwonde and Zomba. If you donated your Qurbani in Malawi last year, you provided **14.3 kilograms** of beef – **4.5 kilograms** each to **3** vulnerable families.

# NIGERIA

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Nigeria in 2022 provided **15 kilograms** of meat, split between **4 to 5** families.



Half of all people in Nigeria live below the poverty line, with huge inequality between the poorest and wealthiest families. Widows in particular face stigma and social obstacles, which drastically affect their ability to provide for their children.

With your help last Dhul Hijjah, we provided nutritious beef to **1,170** families in Oyo, Ogun, and Lagos. If you donated your Qurbani in Nigeria during Dhul Hijjah, you provided **15 kilograms** of beef — that's **3.5 kilograms** each to **4 or 5** vulnerable families.

# PAKISTAN

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Pakistan in 2022 provided over **14 kilograms** of meat, split between **4 to 5** families.



In Pakistan, **11 million** people need humanitarian assistance and **37%** don't know where their next meal will come from. Almost half of all children are stunted.

With your support last Qurbani, we provided **31,532** people with fresh nutritious beef in Mansehra, Rajanpur, and Bahawalpur.

If you performed your Qurbani in Pakistan in 2022, you provided **14.3 kilograms** of beef — that's **3.8 kilograms** each to **4 or 5** vulnerable families, including families headed by women, older people, and people with disabilities.

# PAKISTAN-ADMINISTERED KASHMIR

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Pakistan-administered Kashmir in 2022 provided **14.3 kilograms** of meat, split between **4 to 5 families**.



In Pakistan-administered Kashmir, more than 1 million people struggle with poverty. That's a quarter of the population who struggle to fulfil their basic needs on a daily basis. The rate of unemployment in the region is almost double the national average in Pakistan, and more than **400,000** people cannot find work to sustain a decent livelihood.

With your support last Qurbani, we provided **8,749** people with fresh nutritious beef in the Bagh District.

If you performed your Qurbani in Pakistan-administered Kashmir in 2022, you provided **14.3 kilograms** of beef — that's **3.8 kilograms** each to **4 or 5** vulnerable families, including families headed by women, older people, and people living with disabilities.

# PALESTINE

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Palestine in 2022 provided over **25 kilograms** of meat, split between **10** families.



A staggering **1.6 million** Palestinians don't have enough to eat and in Gaza, almost **69%** are food insecure. The debilitating blockade, consistent airstrikes, and high levels of unemployment in Gaza have made it almost impossible to make a reliable living.

With your support last Qurbani, we provided **11,720** people with fresh, nutritious beef across the Gaza Strip.

Due to the challenges Palestinians face with ongoing power/electricity cuts, it is difficult to preserve fresh meat at home, requiring smaller packages of Qurbani meat to families.

If you donated your Qurbani in Palestine during Dhul Hijjah, you provided **25.5 kilograms** of beef to **10 or 11** vulnerable families, including families headed by women, older people, and people with disabilities.

# SOMALIA

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Somalia in 2022 provided **9.6 kilograms** of meat to **one or two** families.



Somalia is on the brink of famine after five seasons without enough rain - the worst drought in seventy years. A staggering **8.3 million** people are at risk of famine. Compared to last year, **2.2 million** more people are facing acute food insecurity, meaning they urgently need food now to survive.

With your help last Dhul Hijjah, we provided fresh nutritious beef to **11,382** people in Mogadishu. If you donated your Qurbani in Somalia last year, you provided an average of **9.6 kilograms** of beef to a family in Mogadishu or Banadir. Last year we focused on families who were forced to flee their home because of drought or those headed by women.

# SUDAN

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Sudan in 2022 provided more than **14 kilograms** of meat, split between **3** families.



Cyclical drought, flooding, and conflict have displaced **3 million** people in Sudan, and left a staggering **15 million** without reliable access to food – that's a third of the entire population of Sudan.

In 2022, your Qurbani charity provided **927** people in Khartoum with fresh nutritious beef. If you donated your Qurbani in Sudan last Dhul Hijjah, you provided **14.28 kilograms** of beef – that's around **5 kilograms** each to around **3** vulnerable families that are headed by widows.

# SYRIA

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Syria in 2022 provided **22.5 kilograms** of meat, split between **7** families.



**6.8 million** Syrians are displaced, and a staggering **12.1 million** people don't have a reliable way to feed themselves – that's more than half of the entire population. Since the conflict in Ukraine, food prices have skyrocketed, with the cost of basic foods increasing by **90%** since the previous year.

In 2022, your Qurbani charity provided **3,916** people in Idlib and northern Aleppo with fresh nutritious mutton or lamb. If you donated your Qurbani in Syria last Dhul Hijjah, you provided **22.5 kilograms** of beef — that's **3.2 kg** to each of **7** vulnerable displaced families.

# YEMEN

Each Qurbani sacrifice in Yemen in 2022 provided **7 kilograms** of meat, split between **2 families**.



After more than seven years of conflict, more than **4 million** people, are displaced and over **23 million** Yemenis need humanitarian help. **2.2 million** small children need treatment for malnutrition.

This year, your Qurbani donations provided **1,200** of sacrifices to **2,400** families. If you donated your Qurbani in Yemen during Dhul Hijjah, you provided **7 kilograms** of goat — that's **3.5 kilograms** when split between **2** vulnerable families.

# UK

Each Qurbani sacrifice in the United Kingdom in 2022 provided over **7 kilograms** of meat to foodbanks in Birmingham and London.



Food insecurity is on the rise in the UK, with nearly 5 million adults lacking access to food. Following the twin crises of the COVID-19 pandemic and rising inflation, an increasing number of households are struggling to afford food.

Last Eid, we helped **43** people to perform their Qurbani. If you gave your Qurbani here in the UK, we delivered two-thirds of the mutton or lamb to you, and the last third – around **7.1 kilograms** - we donated to foodbanks supporting refugees and low income families in London and Birmingham.
