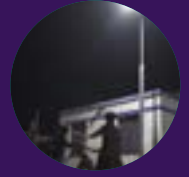

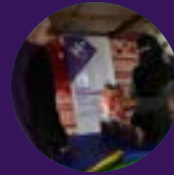

## WELCOME TO OUR MONTHLY ROUND-UP APRIL EDITION

In April, we continued our commitment to serving humanity.

Our cataract surgery campaign in Bangladesh restored sight to hundreds, while in Gaza, we delivered essential aid—bread, flour, vegetables, hot meals, clothing, healthcare, and education for children. In Lebanon, our large-scale REACH deployment brought food parcels, hot meals, dignity kits, and joy-filled activities for orphaned children.

We celebrated Eid with orphaned children in Morocco and responded to the earthquake in Myanmar with emergency food parcels and essential supplies. In Pakistan, we advanced flood recovery efforts by constructing a mosque and installing solar-powered streetlights.

In Senegal, we distributed meat packages, built water wells and classrooms, and supported families with dairy animals for long-term sustainability. Families in Somalia received meat packages, while in Sudan, we distributed hygiene kits.

In Syria, we trained residents in displacement camps on fire safety and continued providing medical care through Al Iman Hospital, Al-Zohoor Health Centre, and our mobile clinic. We also improved camp conditions and organised an Eid celebration for children.

Finally, in Yemen, we installed water tanks in mosques to ensure worshippers can perform ablutions.

# BANGLADESH



## HEALTH

Human Appeal has begun a cataract reduction surgery campaign in Bangladesh, helping individuals regain their sight through accessible and free medical care in remote communities. So far, we have provided **280 cataract surgeries**, along with providing eye medicine and spectacles when necessary, and we are planning to reach a total of **1,743 patients**.

## FOOD SECURITY

We distributed over **5,320 bundles of bread** in Gaza during April, offering a vital source of nourishment as local bakeries were forced to close.

## FOOD SECURITY

Human Appeal distributed parcels of vegetables containing tomatoes, cucumbers, onions, cauliflower, green peppers, and eggplants, improving the limited access the residents of Gaza have faced following the blockade.



## SHELTER

Human Appeal continues to remove solid waste from displacement camps in the south and centre of Gaza, helping to reduce the spread of disease and improve the conditions of the camps.

## HEALTH

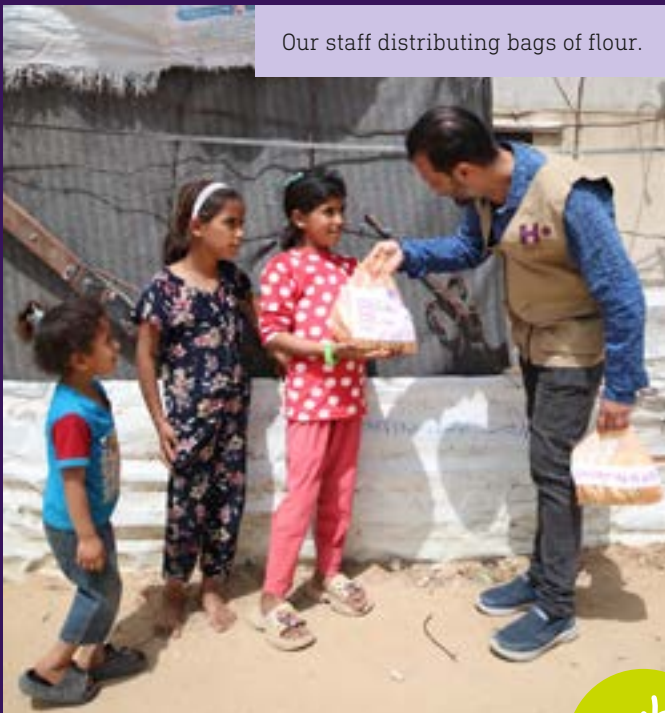


Over the month of April, the six mobile clinics we operate in Gaza have provided medical care to over **822 people**.

## FOOD SECURITY



Human Appeal also delivered **1,544 bags of flour** to families in Gaza, empowering them to bake their own bread and preserve a sense of normalcy amid crisis.

## EDUCATION



In Gaza, **750 children** have been attending our ten emergency schools, which not only offer education but also provide psychosocial support and a safe environment to learn and grow.

## LIVELIHOODS



**1,512 families** received clothes to help keep them warm despite the limited housing available in Gaza.

## FOOD SECURITY



Over the month of April, **74,665 hot meals** were distributed across Gaza, reaching over **12,502 families**, approximately **74,665 people**. So far, Human Appeal has distributed **6.5 million hot meals** in Gaza.

## CHILD WELFARE



Between the 16th and 20th of April, Human Appeal held four fun days for **600 students** in Gaza. The events were packed with games, puppet shows, folk art, clowns and talent performances—offering moments of laughter and joy in difficult times.

## WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE (WASH)



Human Appeal distributed **200,500 litres of water** in Khan Younis, providing **33,417 people** from **6,683 families** with clean, drinkable water.

## REACH



We successfully delivered comprehensive humanitarian support to vulnerable communities, reaching hundreds of families and children in need. A total of **150 food parcels** were packed and distributed, benefitting **100 Syrian families** who received food parcels, fresh produce, bread, toys, and sweets. Additionally, **82 Lebanese families** were supported with hot meals, meat parcels, dignity kits, and children's gifts. Another **100 Syrian families** received essential food items, and a community dinner was organised, serving **200 people**. We also extended support to **100 Palestinian families** with food and bread. Our focus on children included two special events—one for **100 orphaned children** and another fun-filled day for 50 orphans, both featuring gifts, hot meals, and joyful activities.

## CHILD WELFARE



Human Appeal organised an Eid party for **300 orphans** in Morocco, providing them with a traditional Moroccan breakfast, and letting them enjoy a day of fun at an outdoor park, concluding with dinner and gifts.

## EMERGENCY RESPONSE



After a powerful earthquake struck the Mandalay region of Myanmar, Human Appeal provided urgent support, distributing **1,000 food and non-food parcels** to families across five affected villages, helping them recover with dignity.

# PAKISTAN



## SHELTER

Human Appeal is constructing a mosque in the village of Abdul Karim Chandio in Pakistan, which Human Appeal helped to rebuild. This mosque will be able to hold **150 people** at once, and serve as a centre for the whole community.

## SHELTER

Human Appeal has successfully constructed more than **574 flood-resilient homes** in the regions of Qambar Shahdadkot and Dadu in Pakistan, as well as installing solar-powered lights in the villages where we worked.

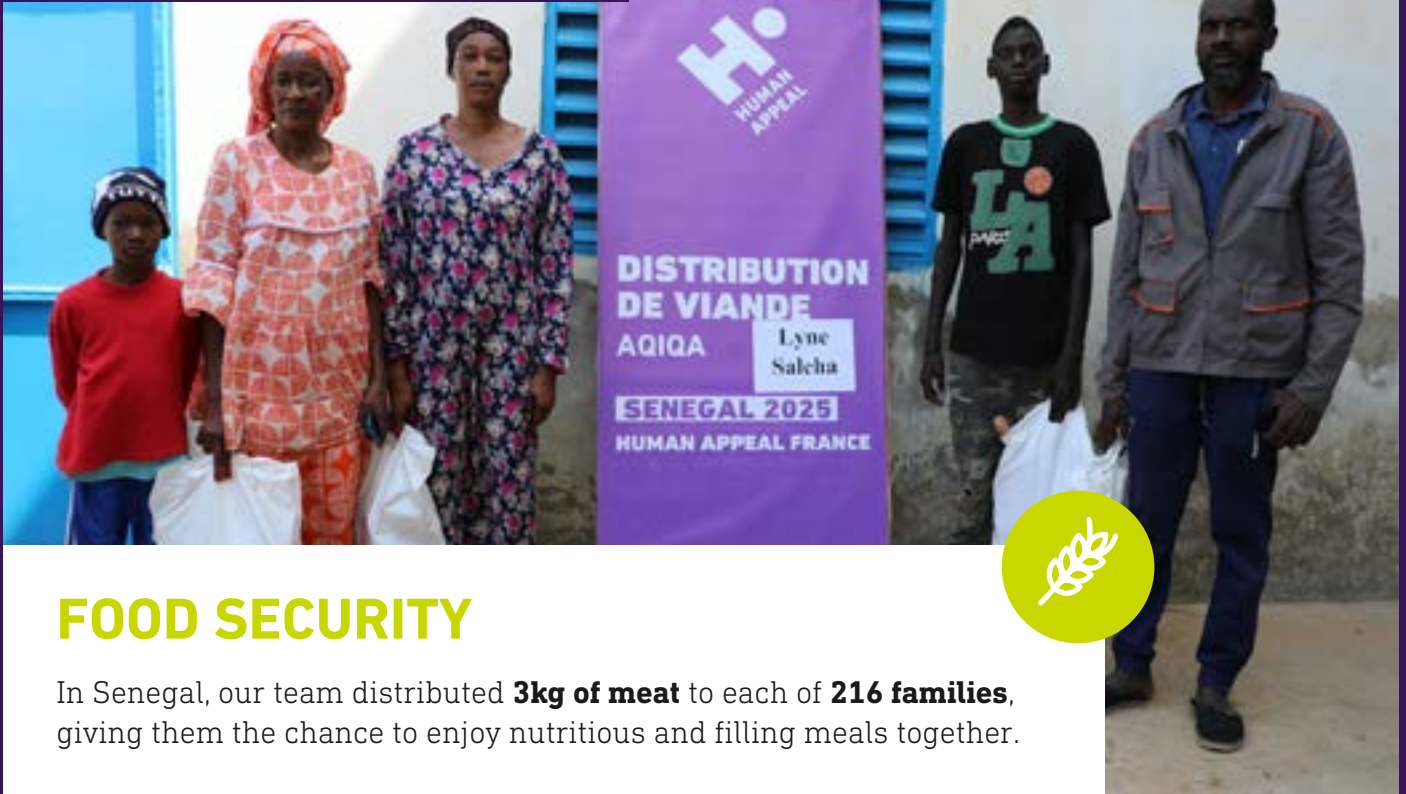

# SENEGAL

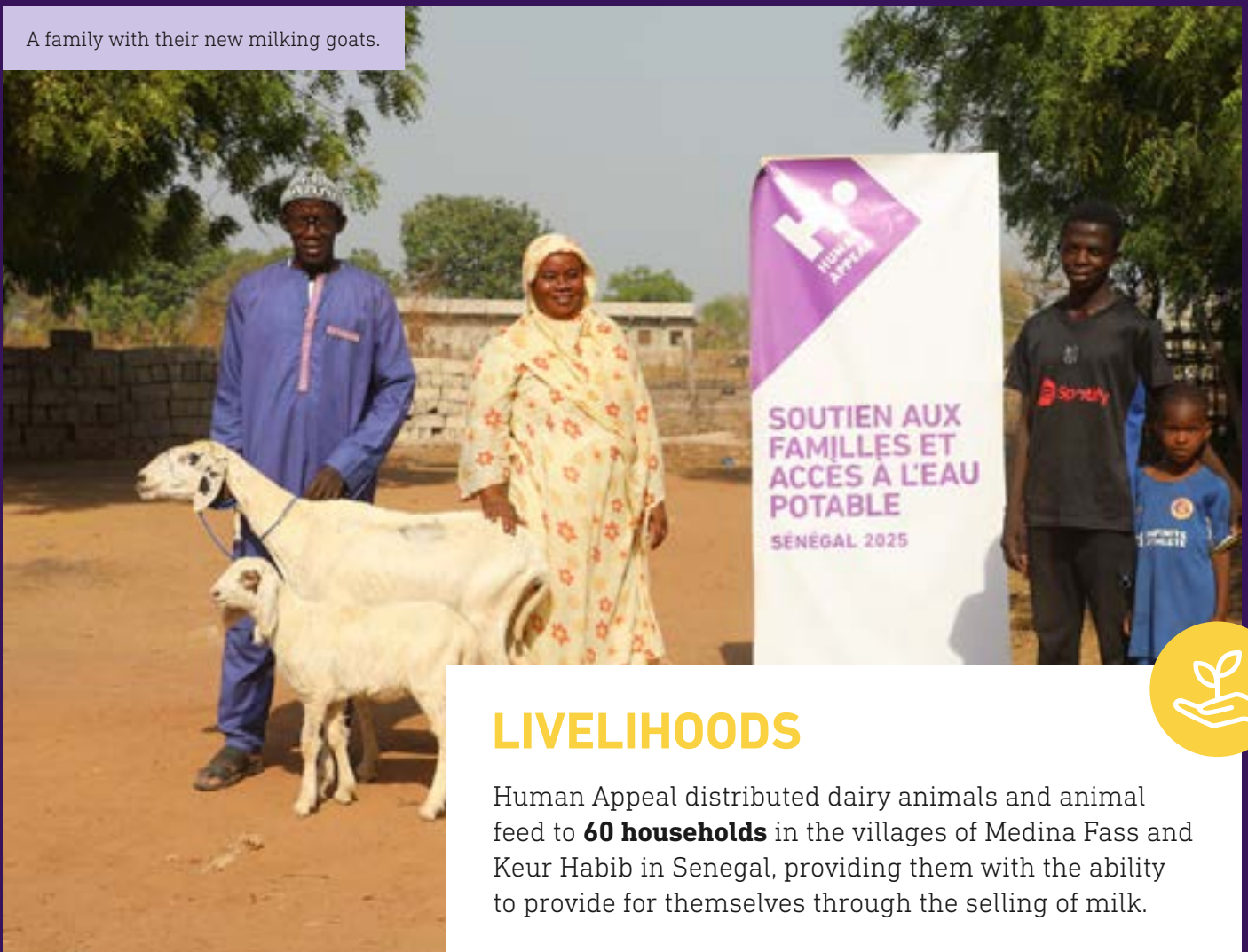

## FOOD SECURITY

In Senegal, our team distributed **3kg of meat** to each of **216 families**, giving them the chance to enjoy nutritious and filling meals together.

## LIVELIHOODS

Human Appeal distributed dairy animals and animal feed to **60 households** in the villages of Medina Fass and Keur Habib in Senegal, providing them with the ability to provide for themselves through the selling of milk.

## WASH



We have inaugurated four solar-powered water wells in four villages in the Fatick and Thies regions of Senegal, ensuring around **1,350 people** have access to clean water.





## IMAN'S STORY

Iman lost her sister to the fighting in Mosul in 2014 and endured many years of hardship. But thanks to training from the United Nations Development Programme and Human Appeal, she learned the art of baking pastries and confectionery.

Now, Iman works as a chef's assistant, runs her own home-based pastry business, and dreams of one day opening a shop to help other women in her community find employment. Her story is one of resilience, hope, and sweet success.

## FOOD SECURITY

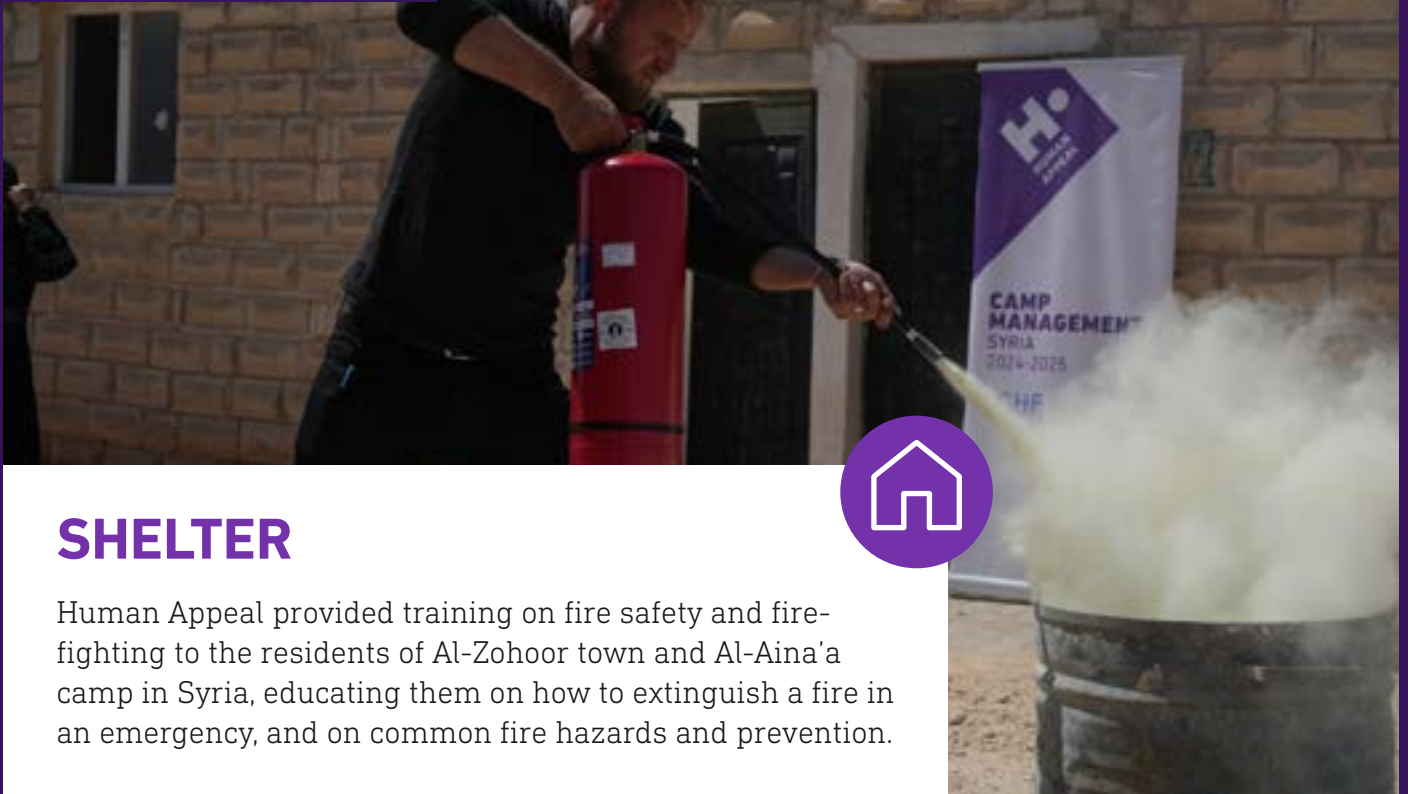
## WASH

In Sudan, we distributed **2,500 hygiene kits** to families in the Sharg Aneel region. Each kit included essentials such as soap, washing powder, toothbrushes, sanitary pads, and more. We plan to distribute **2,500 more** to reach even more families in need.

## SHELTER

Human Appeal's Al-Zohoor health centre in Syria continues to provide free medical services to the residents of Al-Zohoor.

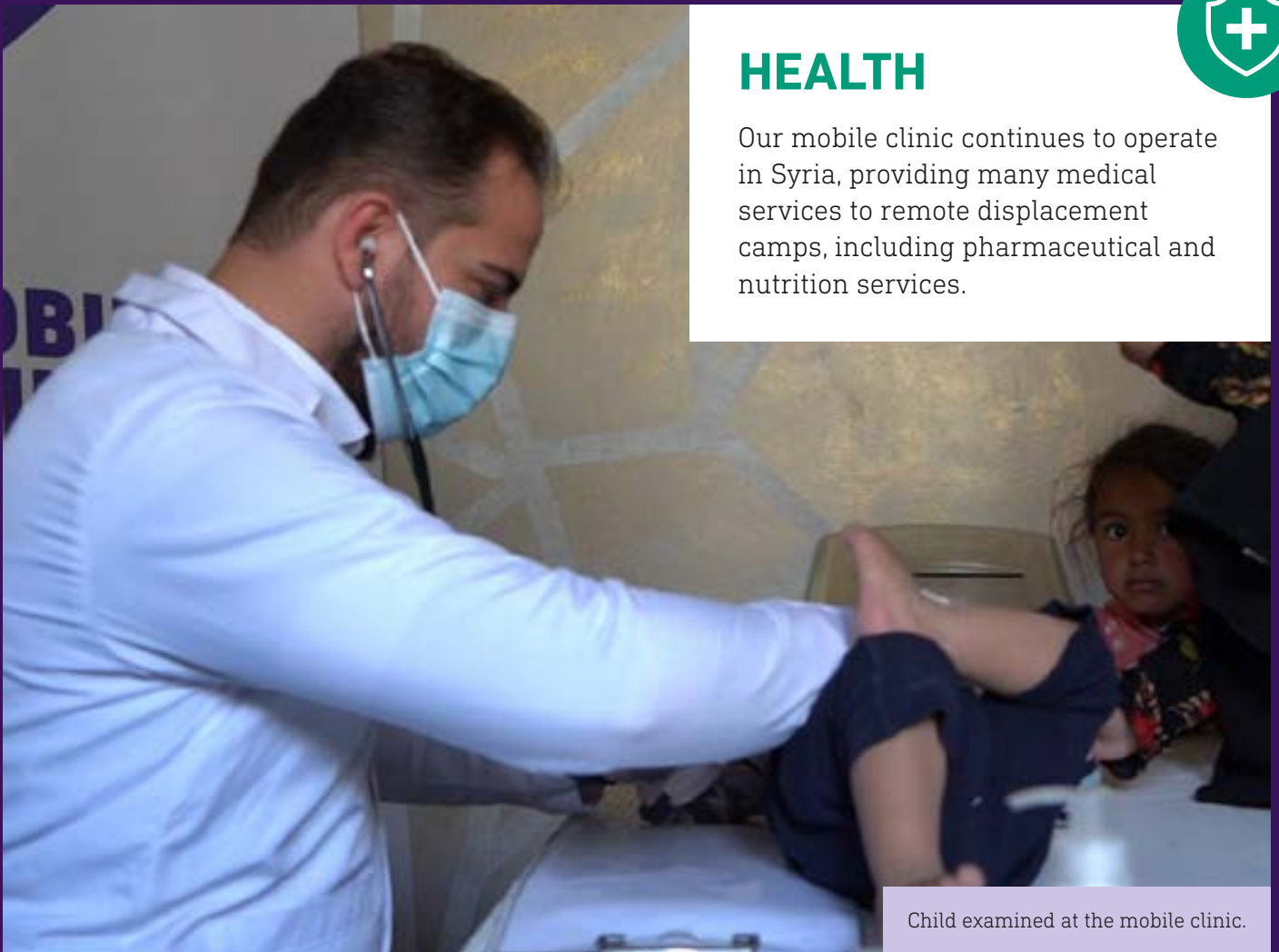

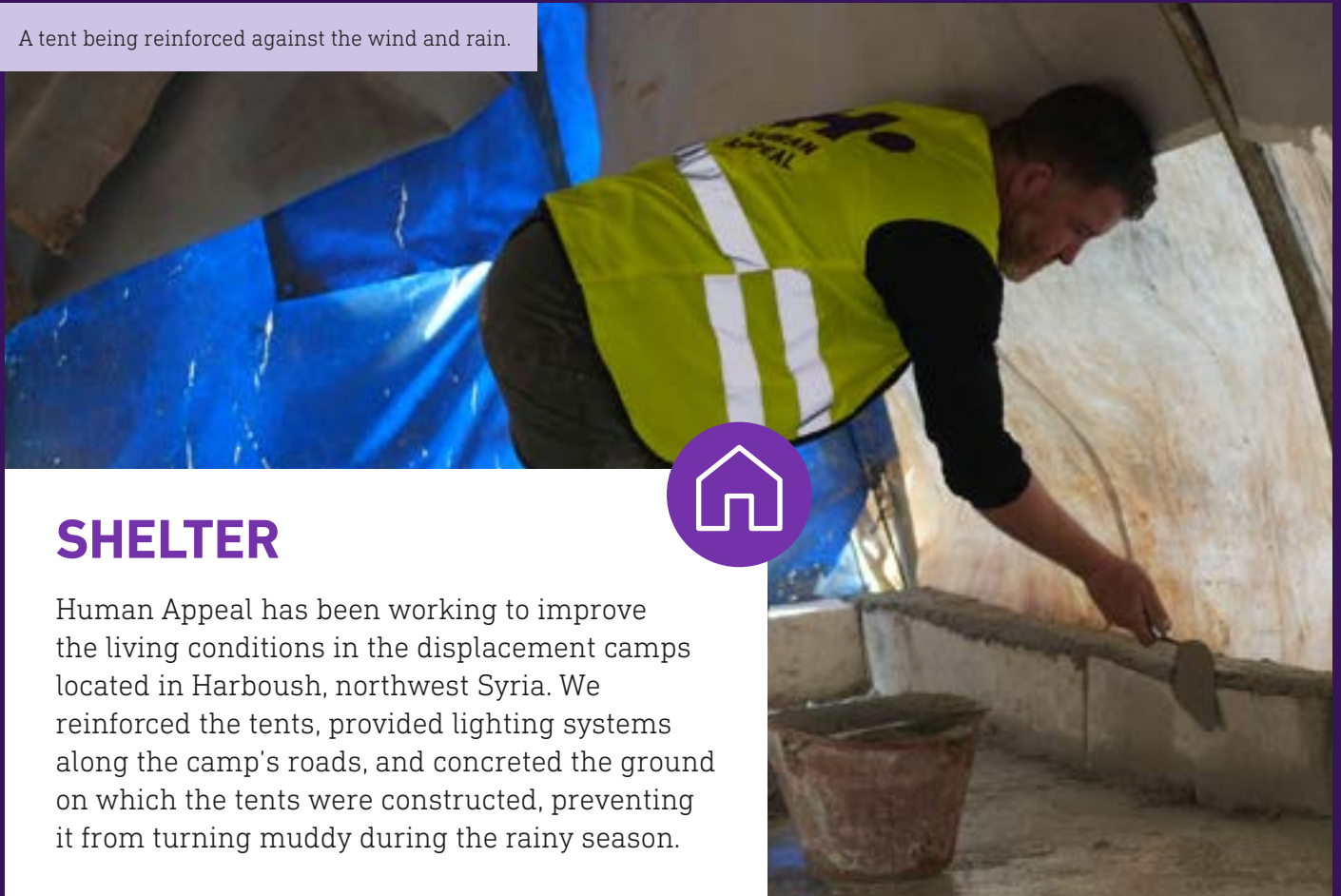
## CHILD WELFARE

## SHELTER

Human Appeal has been working to improve the living conditions in the displacement camps located in Harboush, northwest Syria. We reinforced the tents, provided lighting systems along the camp's roads, and concreted the ground on which the tents were constructed, preventing it from turning muddy during the rainy season.

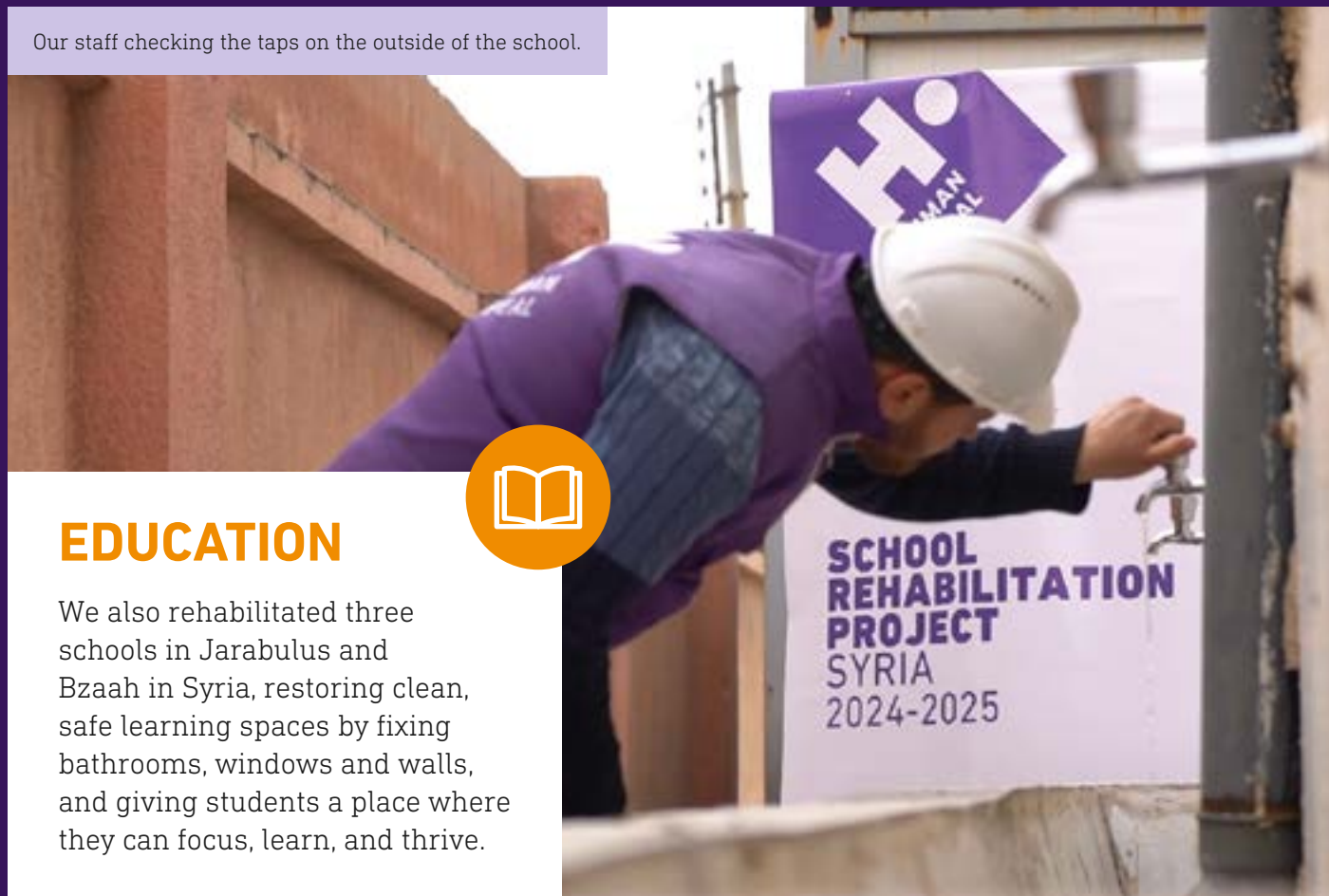

## EDUCATION

Al-Sabr School, built by Human Appeal in Al Zohoor village, continues to support **1,300 children** displaced by conflict, offering education alongside vital emotional care.

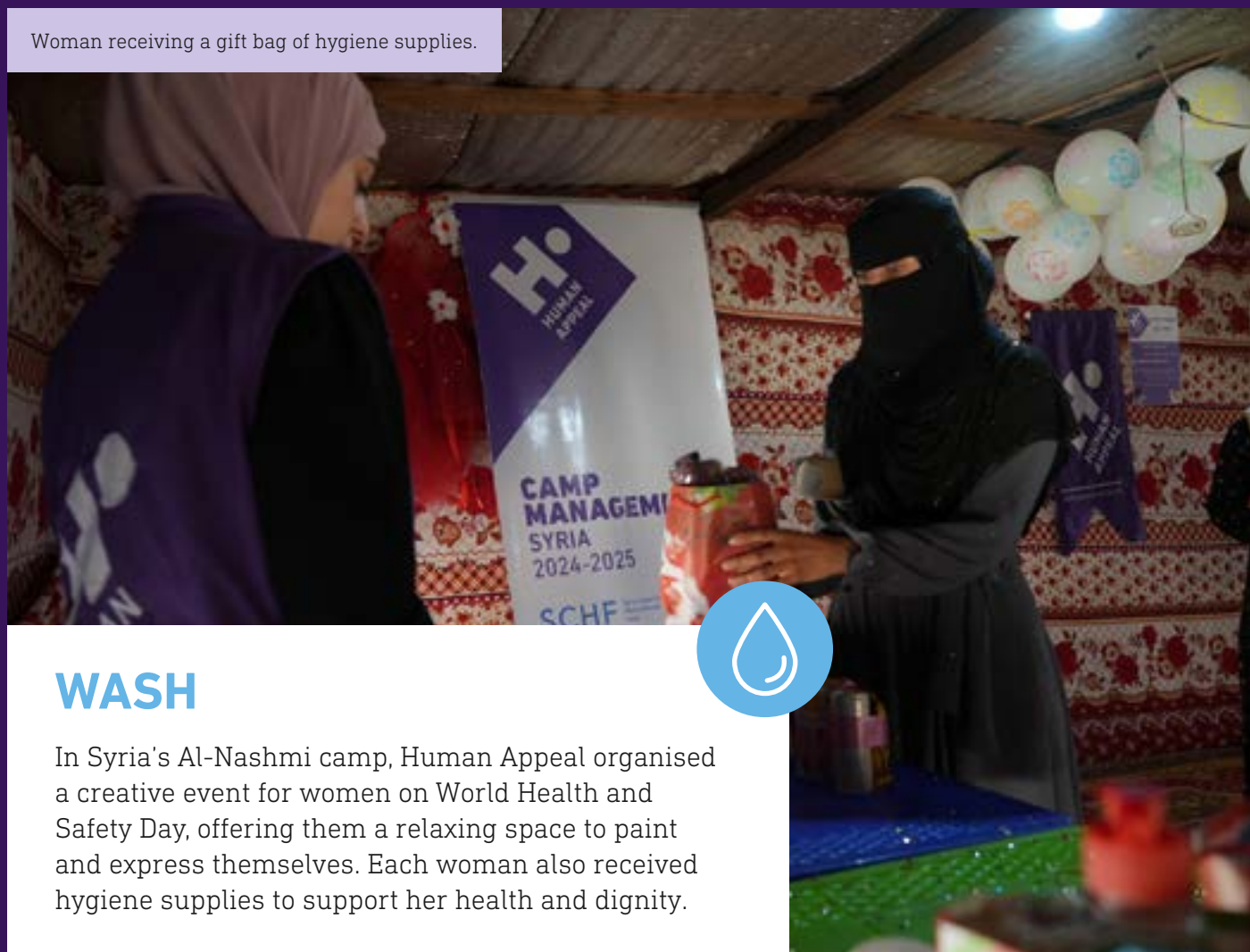

## EDUCATION

We also rehabilitated three schools in Jarabulus and Bzaah in Syria, restoring clean, safe learning spaces by fixing bathrooms, windows and walls, and giving students a place where they can focus, learn, and thrive.

## WASH
